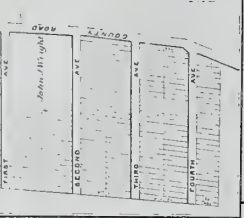
STEELES SUBDIVISION of Branch Hill

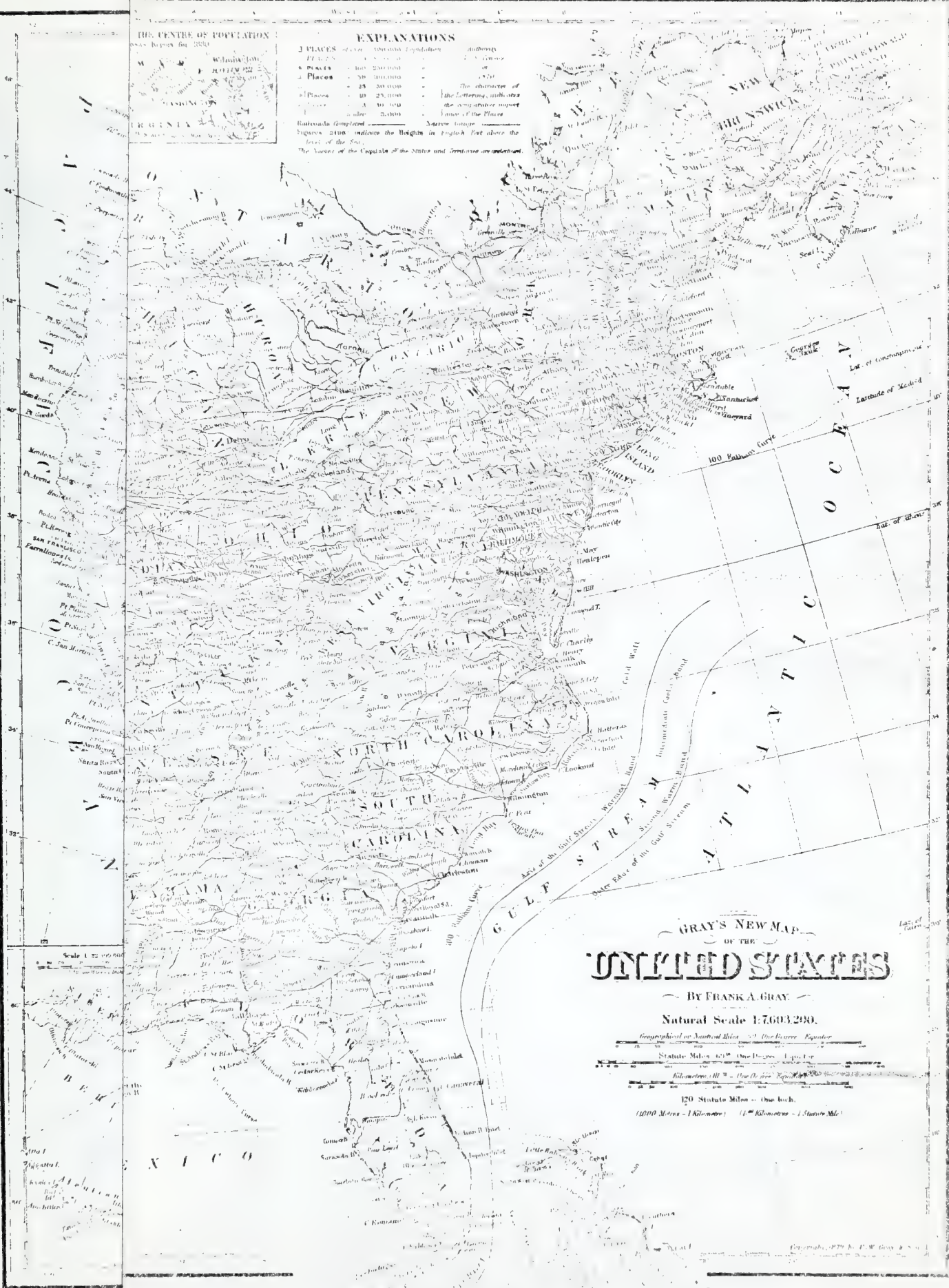

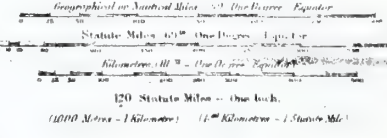
Barometric Heights in English feet above the level of the Sea.

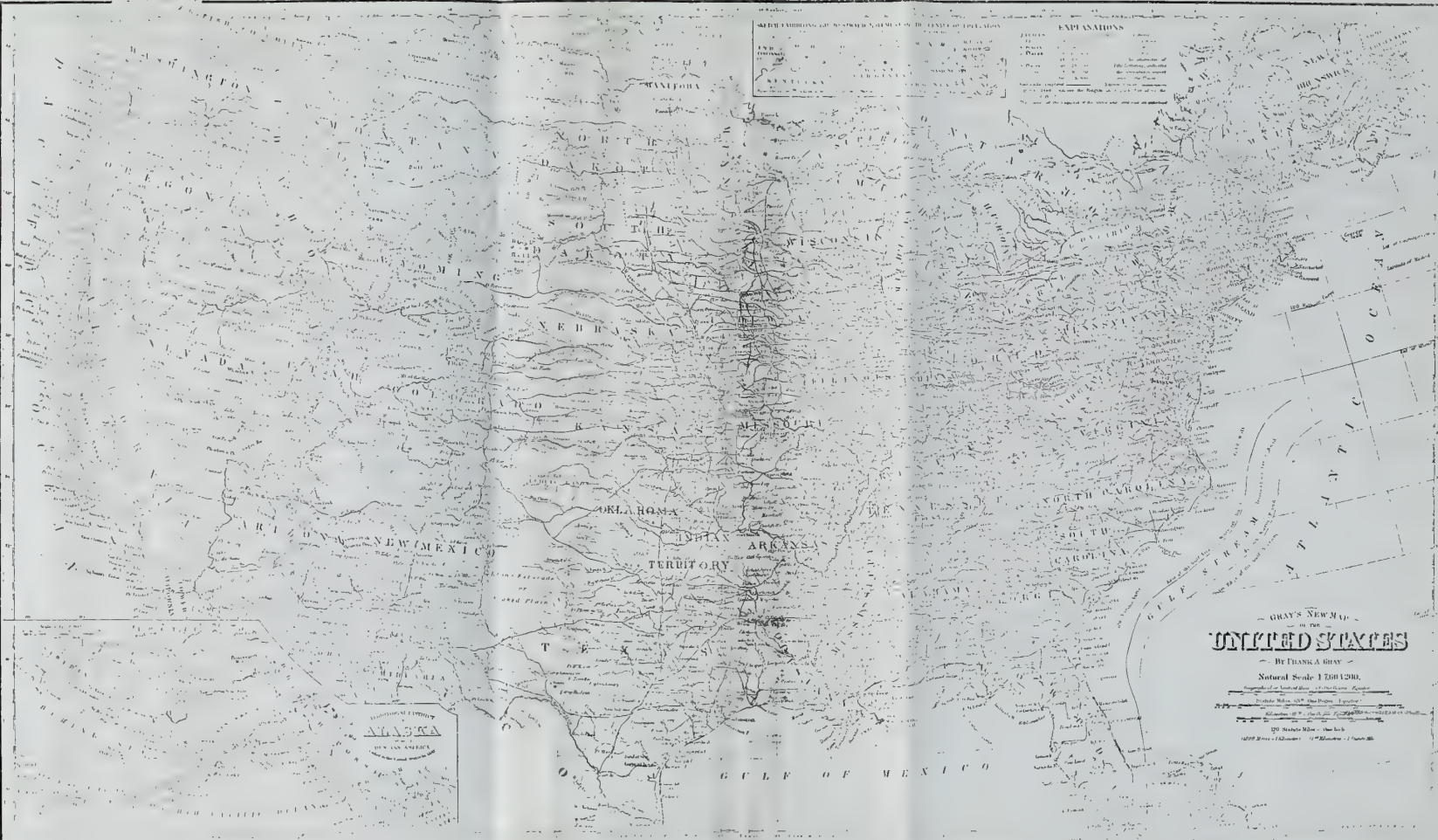

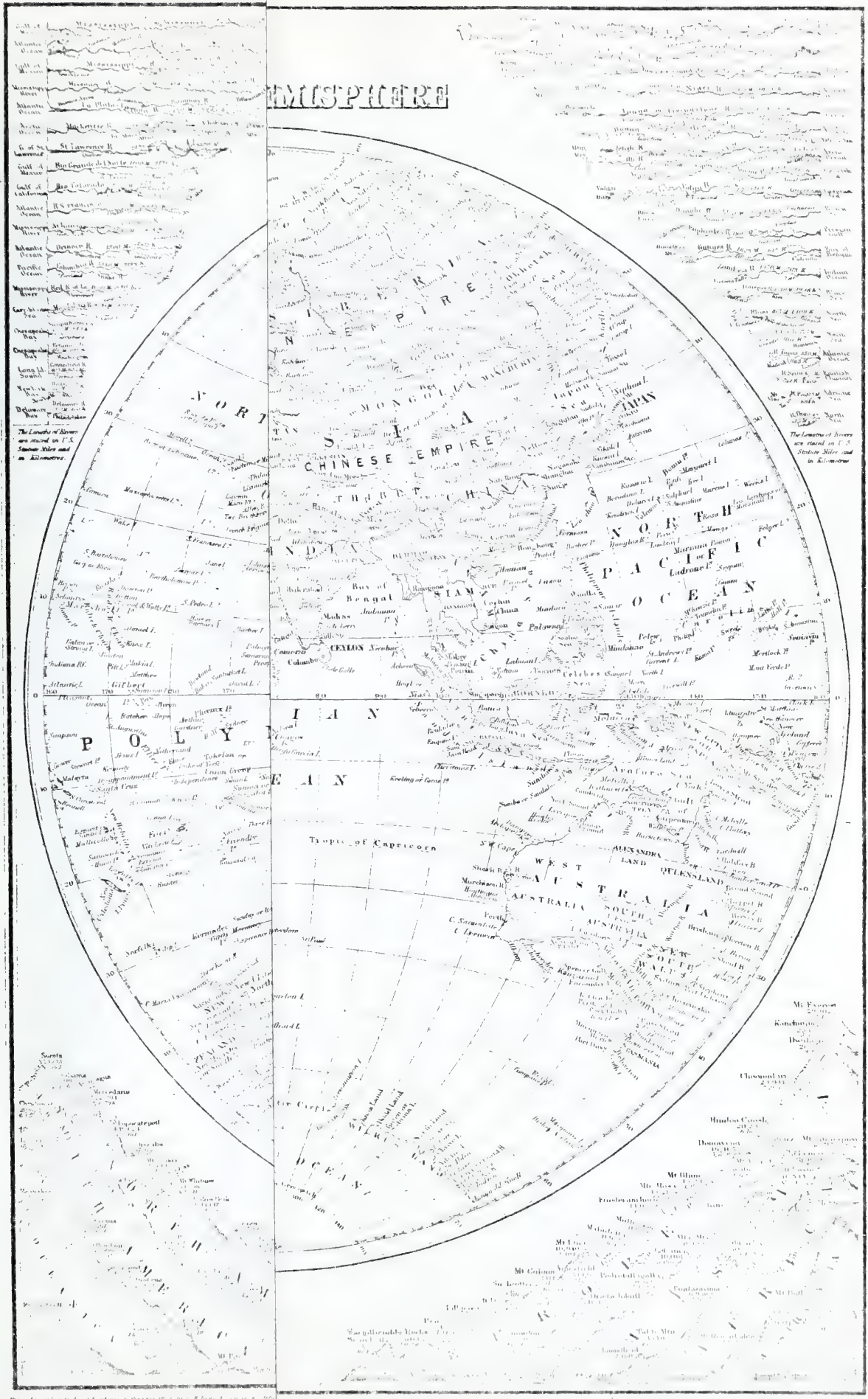

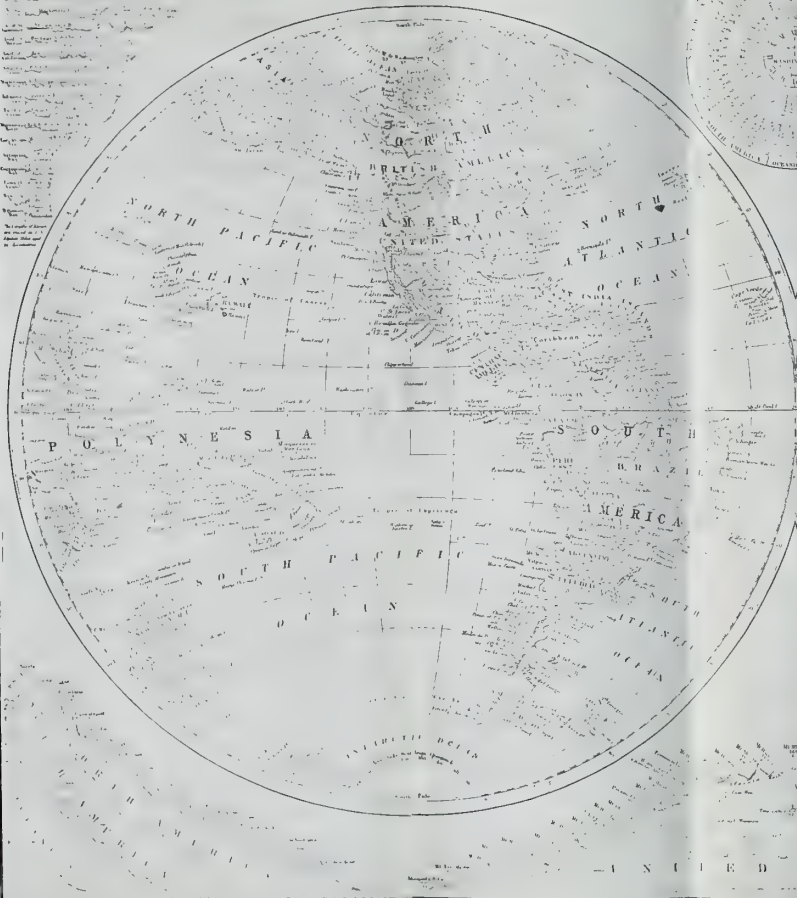
