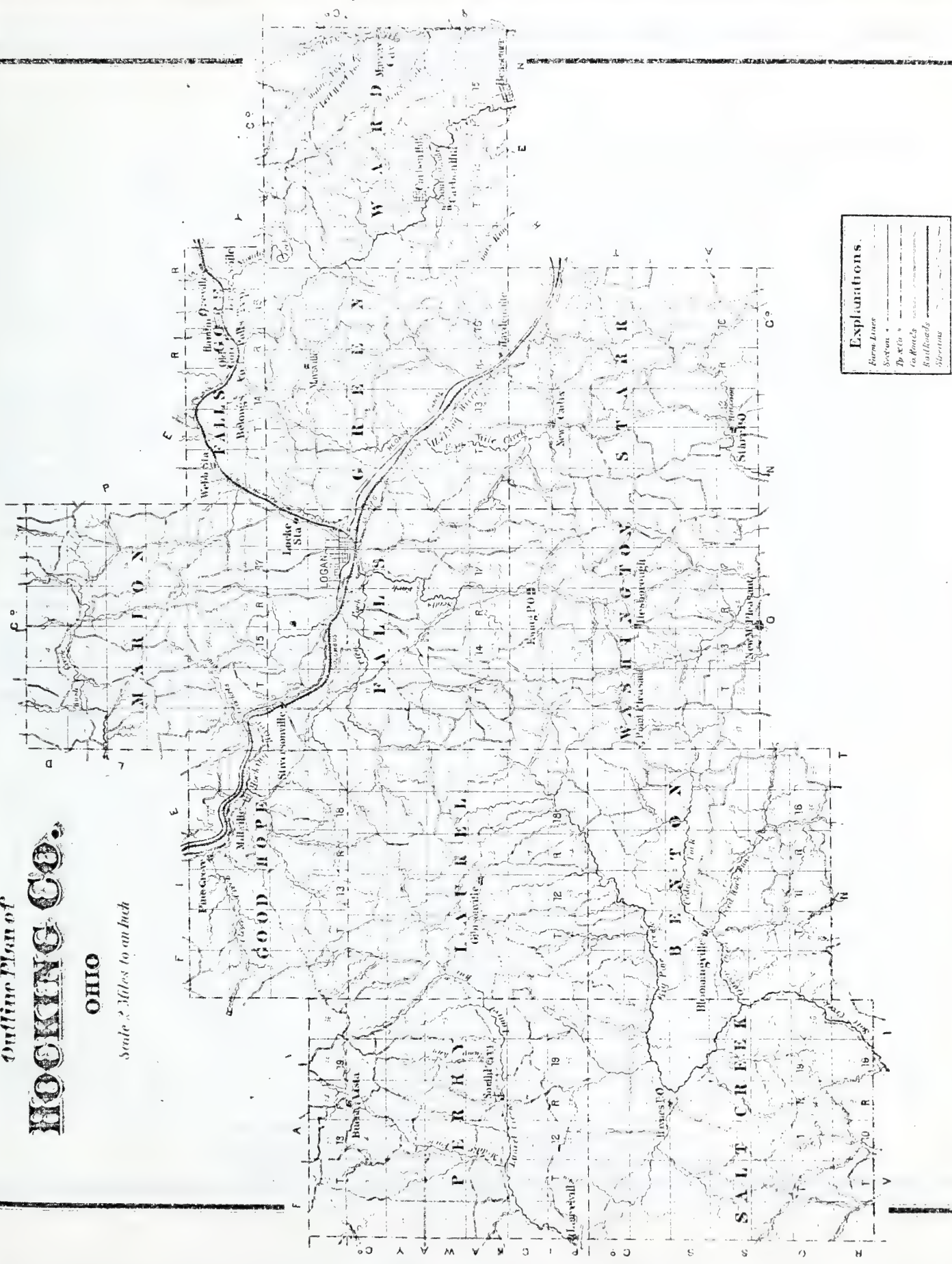
TOWNSHIP AND RAILROAD MAP OF THE STATE OF OHIO.

Outline Plan of HOOKING CO.

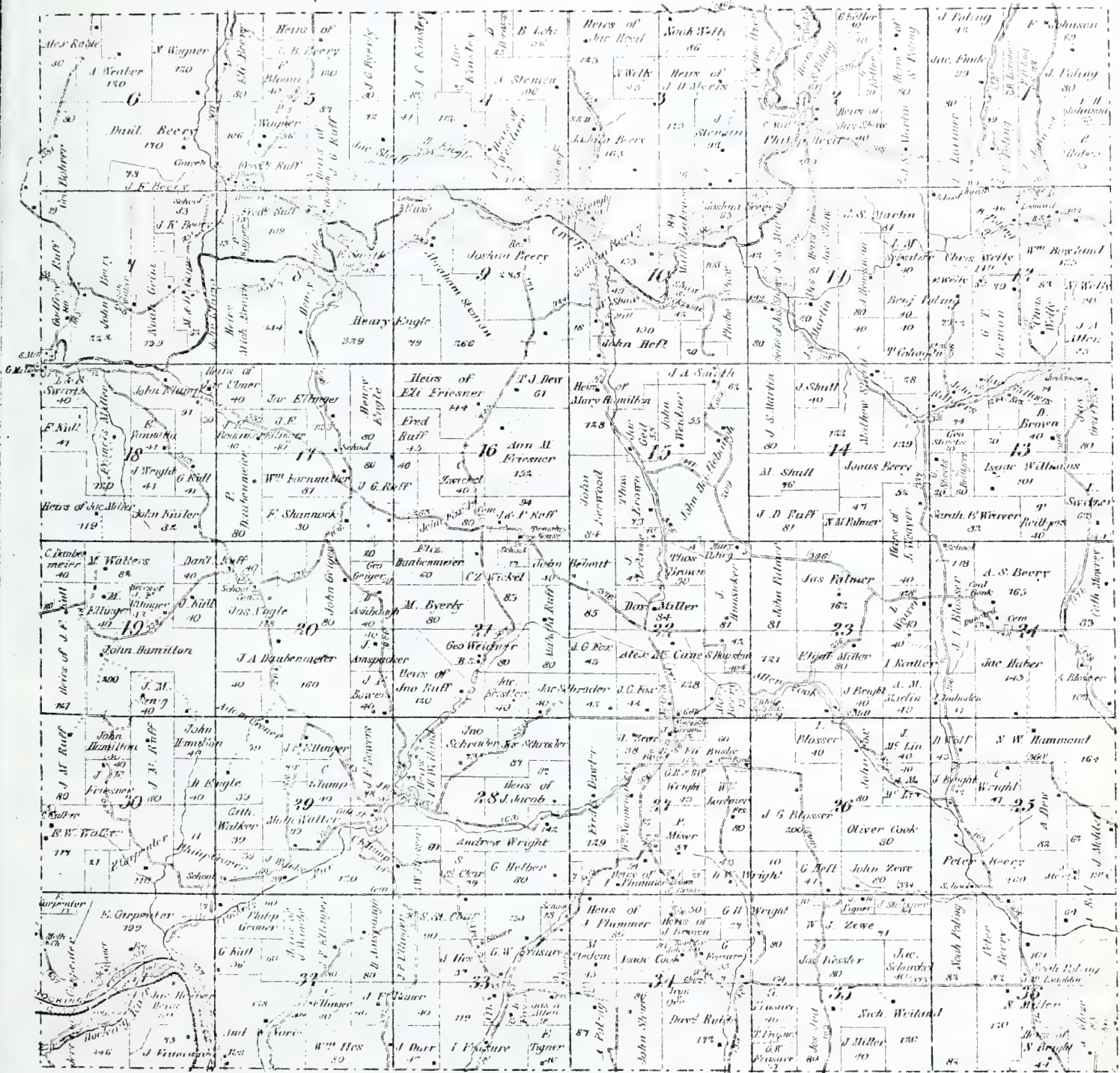

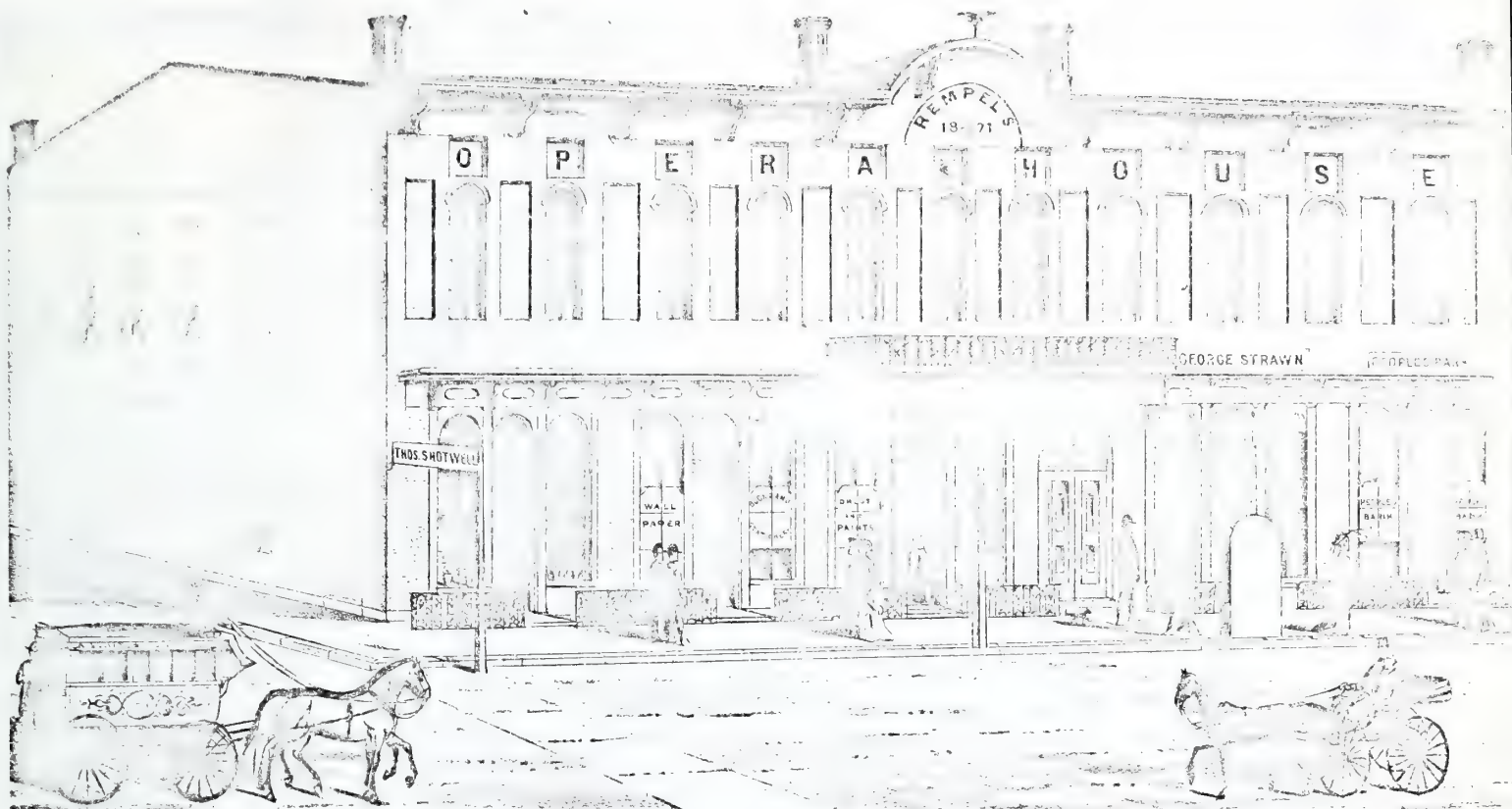


FALLS
