# REPORT

FOR THE

YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31ST, 1875.

---

---

THE year 1875 has been remarkable for the continued prevalence of Scarlet Fever, which began to assume epidemic proportions in the last six months of 1874. To this is chiefly due the large increase in the number of admissions, which, during the year, have amounted to 710, the number admitted in 1874 having been 384, in 1873 only 167. Of the 710 cases admitted, 329 were males, 381 females; 634 were cases of contagious Fever, 76 diseases other than Fever, certified on admission to be suffering from Fever.

Typhus Fever has been almost absent from London during the year, and only 8 cases have been received into the Hospital, but one boy contracted this disease during convalescence from Scarlatina. The circumstances of the case are sufficiently remarkable for special mention. When the symptoms of Typhus developed themselves in him there was no other patient affected with this form of Fever in the Hospital, and the only case admitted while he was in the ward was that of a woman, who was therefore in the opposite wing, and from whom it was scarcely possible that contagion should have reached him, directly or indirectly; this patient, moreover, died within four hours of admission. The boy's father had died of



Typhus during the last epidemic, and the family had suffered severely, which might explain great susceptibility to the influence of the poison, but not spontaneous origin of the disease, and no exposure to contagion could be traced by the most careful inquiry, until at length it was ascertained that after the arrival of the ambulance with the case of Typhus already mentioned, and before it was disinfected, this boy and others amused themselves by climbing into it.

Of the 9 cases of Typhus, 3 died, giving a mortality of 33·3 per cent., but deducting one case in which death occurred within four hours of admission, the mortality of all the cases treated to their termination during the year is 22·2 per cent. Three of the patients suffering from Typhus came from other Hospitals, and paid a fee, the remainder were admitted free.

Of Enteric Fever, 68 cases were admitted—30 males and 38 females—and they were very evenly distributed through the year, the summer and autumn rise being only slightly perceptible. Three patients occupied private wards, 30 paid the usual fee on admission, and 33 were admitted free, two only bringing Governors' letters.

Of the 71 cases treated to their termination during the year, 12 died, giving a mortality of 16·9 per cent. Deducting one case in which death occurred within twenty-four hours after admission, the rate of mortality becomes 15·4 per cent. Among the males, 34 in number, the number of deaths was 4, giving a mortality of 11·7 per cent. Among the females, 37 in number, 8 died, giving a mortality of 21·6 per cent. Further information respecting Enteric Fever is furnished by the accompanying tables.

It is to Scarlet Fever that the large number of admissions during the year has been due. Of this disease 525 cases have been admitted, 252 males and 273 females, the predominance of females being less than usual. In 1874 the numbers were 207, 90 being males and 114 females. The private wards have been largely made use of by patients suffering from Scarlet Fever, 23 cases having been received in them. At one time all the eight rooms were occupied, and during the year they have scarcely ever all been empty. The ordinary admission fee has been paid with 299 patients, 193 have been admitted free, and 10 by Governors' orders. According to the Registrar-General's returns, and those of the

Pauper Fever Asylums, the epidemic is on the decline, but this is not yet seen in the Fever Hospital. In the first six months of the year 155 cases were received, in the last six months 370, while November and December show the highest numbers, 78 and 74 respectively.

Of the cases of Scarlet Fever, 460 in number, treated to their termination during the year, 50 have died, giving a general mortality of 10·8 per cent. Deducting 7 cases in which death occurred within twenty-four hours of admission, the mortality is 9·3 per cent.

Among males admitted during the year the mortality was 9·6 per cent. ; among females, 8·66. Details of the mortality at different ages, and an enumeration of the more important complications met with, are furnished in the accompanying tables.

Mr. Shirley F. Murphy has succeeded Dr. Mahomed as Resident Medical Officer, and the Committee and Physicians desire to express their high appreciation of the zeal and ability he has shown in the treatment of the cases and management of the Hospital.

The Committee looks back on the work of the year with much satisfaction. The Hospital has rendered important services, and



though formerly larger numbers have passed through its wards, at no period has it been more necessary or more useful. Scarlet Fever, of which 525 cases have been admitted, is eminently contagious, and not for a few days only, but through several weeks, during a great part of which, in the homes of the poor, free communication with the members of the same family and with members of other families habitually takes place. The disease, therefore, would inevitably have been given to many others had these not been secluded, and these again would have become new centres of infection. Scarlet Fever, again, not only endangers life, but very often leaves behind it serious impairment of health.

There is no charitable institution which can have stronger claims on public support, since it not only relieves those stricken with Fever, but protects many more from the danger of infection.

The latter object is never lost sight of, and various modifications in the rules and practice of the Hospital have been made to this end. The admission fee of two guineas formerly required from all who were not supported while in the Hospital by the parishes has now been abandoned in the case of the working classes, and patients belonging to this class are admitted free. The admission fee interfered with that part of the mission of the Institution which is concerned with the prevention of the spread of contagious Fevers by deterring those who could not afford it from applying. It is moreover necessary, both for the sake of the patient and in the interests of those exposed to contagion from him, that the removal to hospital should be effected with as little delay as possible. On this account, letters of recommendation from Governors and Subscribers are not insisted on. The fee, however, is still required from masters who, for the protection of their families, send in servants; but this covers a very small proportion of the cost, especially in the case of Scarlet Fever, which renders necessary an average stay in the Hospital of six weeks. A consideration of the danger, trouble, and expense saved to householders and heads of families by the prompt removal of domestics suffering from Fever ought to secure for the

Hospital more support than it receives at present. A further claim, also, on the support of the richer sections of the public is constituted by the provision made in the private rooms for those who could not be placed in large public wards. All these claims will, the Committee believe, ultimately be recognised. The public is only now slowly learning to avail itself of the advantages offered by the Hospital, and when those advantages are more known and felt they will be appreciated, and bring to the Institution the support it needs. Meanwhile large extra expenses have been incurred in repairs and alterations, rendered necessary by the change in the class of patients seeking admission, and the increase of ordinary expenditure caused by the increased number of cases has not yet been met by increase of income. Much capital has consequently been sold out, and the resources of the Hospital are gradually being diminished. It is the earnest hope of the Committee that any crippling of its usefulness may be averted.

The thanks of the Committee are due to the public and medical press for their co-operation in making known the claims of the Hospital, and especially to the *Times*, which has always been alive to the importance of the work done by the Hospital.

*Extract from the "TIMES" Newspaper, 21st August,  
1875.*

In the enormous aggregate of misery and mischief which is produced in this Metropolis by the prevalence of the various zymotic or self-propagating diseases, by far the largest portion is directly traceable to their infectious character, and depends upon the risk, amounting almost to certainty, that they will spread from person to person in any small household into which they gain admission. Physicians and sanitary reformers teach with one accord that this danger can only be set aside by the speedy and complete separation of the sick from those among the healthy who are susceptible of the particular contagion of each malady; and in large mansions, with numerous rooms and with more than one staircase, such separation can be enforced at home without insurmountable difficulty. But there are innumerable houses, occupied by people holding decent and comfortable positions in life, in which no arrangement of the kind is possible, in which the available space is fully tenanted, in which there is only a single staircase, and in which that single staircase is common to two or more families, or to different sets of lodgers. Worse still, there are many in which various trades and businesses are carried on which cannot be interfered with or suspended on account of the



presence of sickness, so that the customers at a shop, or the employers of a workman, may themselves receive contagion they know not whence. The conditions supposed are not only perilous to the healthy, but they are also, and in an extreme degree, prejudicial to the sick. The most essential conditions to the favourable progress of any kind of infectious fever is that there should be a free and constant renewal of air about the patient, and this condition can only be fulfilled by ample cubic space and effectual ventilation. The oppressive atmosphere of an ordinary bedroom, which cannot be changed except by opening windows perhaps directly overhanging the sick bed, enormously diminishes the chances of recovery; and these chances are diminished still further when the room is also a dwelling-place or a workshop for other members of a family, or, as it often must become, a ward for the reception of more than a single patient. The size of London and the costliness of house-room have occasioned, even among the middle classes, a great amount of what can only be described as overcrowding; and there are miles upon miles of reputable streets in which scarcely a single house would afford in time of sickness security for the healthy, or a reasonable chance of recovery for the patient. If the sufferer is a member of the family, the matter is bad enough; but when, as often happens, some infectious disease attacks a domestic servant, it is difficult to say whether the patient or the employers are the more legitimate objects of commiseration.

The difficulties hence arising are of course not new in their essential nature, neither is it new that they should be made subjects of attention. At the very beginning of the century a few benevolent persons endeavoured in some degree to meet them, and for this purpose they rented a house in Gray's Inn Road, and opened it as a place of refuge for patients suffering from fever. The object of the promoters was to remove fever patients from their homes and families, so as to diminish the risk of the disease spreading by contagion, and at the same time to make provision for whitewashing infected rooms, and for burning and replacing infected clothing. The name first selected was "House of Recovery;" and the House of Recovery, after encountering much opposition of various kinds, fought its way from small beginnings to a condition of much usefulness and prosperity. In 1815 it was removed to more commodious premises at King's Cross, where it was first named "the London Fever Hospital;" and, having been driven thence to make way for the terminus of the Great Northern Railway, it was finally established at Islington, in 1848, in buildings which are a model of everything that can be desired in hospital construction. The arrangements for the reception of paupers, at the charge of their various Unions, were so excellent, and so highly appreciated both by the poor and by the Poor Law authorities, that for many years the Hospital was almost entirely devoted to persons of this class; and the great and manifest advantages which its operations conferred upon the community were prominent among the influences which led to the passing of the Metropolitan Asylums Act. Under this Act Public Hospitals were founded which superseded, as far as paupers were concerned, an institution mainly supported by voluntary contributions; and the patients admitted into the Fever Hospital declined from 3,487 in 1870 to 1,324 in 1871, and to 182 in 1872.

Under these changed circumstances the Committee of Management, after due

consideration of the claims upon them and of their resources, felt that the property which they had in trust could be best utilized by rendering the Hospital available for persons above pauperism, but who, from any circumstances, were unable, when attacked by fever, to obtain proper care and attention at their own homes, or whose presence there was a source of danger to others. It was therefore resolved to make the Hospital absolutely free to working men or to any members of their families, not being paupers; and such persons are now admitted at once, without delay, payment, or recommendation, on the production of a certificate from a medical man that they are suffering from contagious fever. Domestic servants, or persons engaged in houses of business, who are sent to the Hospital for the safety and convenience of employers, are admitted on the recommendation of an annual subscriber of one guinea, or on a payment of two guineas on admission, although even the latter sum covers scarcely one-third of the average cost of dealing with such cases. In addition to these arrangements, and to the accommodation provided in the spacious and well-ventilated wards, eight large rooms have been prepared and furnished with every requisite comfort; and in each of them a single patient, or two children from the same family or from the same school, can be received. The payment for one of these rooms, with the attendance of an experienced nurse and the care of the resident medical officer, together with food and medicine, has been fixed at three guineas a week, which would be very much less than the ordinary cost of the cases at home; but the object of the Committee has been to prevent expense being an obstacle to the removal of the sick from places where they would be likely to spread contagion. The phrase "infectious fever" covers a somewhat wide field, and embraces nearly all the acute contagious diseases, not only typhoid, typhus, and relapsing fevers, but also scarlet fever, smallpox, cholera, and measles. All these appear and disappear with the utmost irregularity, becoming suddenly prevalent and as suddenly dying away, so that the Hospital is compelled at all times to maintain an expensive nursing staff in a high degree of efficiency, and to be prepared to deal with outbreaks whenever they occur. In the fulfilment of this essential condition of the usefulness of the institution, it has been necessary to trench upon its invested property to a very large extent; the present income being wholly inadequate to meet the ordinary and necessary outgoings. The managers appeal to the public for help in this emergency, and we trust their appeal may not be made in vain. The work in which they are engaged is not only good in itself—that is, as regards the immediate benefit conferred upon those who are actually received into the wards—but it is also one of great public utility in two ways—first, by preventing infectious fevers from spreading; secondly, by educating the whole community to know how much better such diseases can be treated in a well-founded Hospital than at home. As this knowledge extends, we may reasonably expect that it will be generally applied and that local sanitary authorities all over the kingdom will be stimulated to use the power they now possess of establishing such Hospitals in their several districts, and of rendering them available not only for paupers, but also for those who are able and willing to pay. It is among the regulations of the London Fever Hospital that the patients who occupy the private rooms may, if they so desire, retain the services of their private medical attendants; and there is no reason why such a regulation should not be



adopted elsewhere. Men of science are working earnestly to diminish contagious diseases by tracing them to their sources and by analyzing the conditions which foster them; and it is probable that their researches may soon be rewarded by valuable results. In the meanwhile, the general adoption of Hospitals for such diseases would at once deprive them of half their terrors, and would probably diminish by one-half their prevalence and their mortality. The London Fever Hospital is the pioneer of sanitary progress in this direction, and the modest income necessary for its maintenance ought not to be withheld from those who have conducted it so wisely and so well.

It will be of interest to the Governors to know that the returns of the Hospital are now included in the weekly report of the Registrar General, who acknowledges the importance of the information they afford of the prevalence of fever in a stratum of society not seeking admission into the Pauper Asylums. Another fact of interest is that the sanitary authorities of the parish of Kensington have resolved to send to the Hospital the cases of Fever arising within their jurisdiction among those who, not being paupers, require removal from their homes. It ought also to be known that the Resident Medical Officer, considering it part of his duty to protect the public against the contagion of Fever by every means in his power, has given information to the Police in all cases in which cabs have been employed to convey patients to the Hospital. The ambulance is always at the service of the public, so that no excuse exists for the employment of public vehicles, the danger of which is forcibly illustrated by the case of communication of Typhus mentioned in the early part of this report.

## LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

### Objects of the Institution.

1. ALL poor persons (not being parochial paupers) and domestic servants of subscribers, labouring under contagious fever, and residing in the metropolis or its neighbourhood, shall be considered proper objects for this charity, and shall be admitted gratuitously, according to the next regulation. Domestic servants, employés in houses of business, and others similarly situated, and all inmates of other public charities (except medical hospitals), shall be admitted on the payment of such sum for each patient as the Committee shall from time to time determine.

2. On application for the admission of any patient to the Hospital, notice shall be immediately given to the resident medical officer, and the person after inspection may be admitted by an order signed by him, or on a certificate signed by any physician, surgeon, or apothecary, stating the disease to be *fever of a contagious nature*, or likely to become such. The order or certificate shall entitle the patient to admission, subject to the provisions contained in Rule No. 1, unless the case shall be deemed an improper one by the resident medical officer, or unless the Hospital shall be full.

### Governors.

3. All subscribers of one guinea annually, or of ten guineas in one donation, shall be governors of this Hospital.

### General Meeting and Election of the Committee.

4. A general meeting of the governors, of which ten days' previous notice must be given in three morning newspapers, shall be held every year, on the second Friday in February, or as near thereto as may be convenient, for the purpose of approving or rescinding the proceedings of the Committee for the preceding year; for receiving an annual report of the state of the funds; and for electing a president, vice-presidents, treasurer, honorary secretary, and other members of the Committee for the ensuing year. At all meetings connected with the affairs of the Hospital, a simple majority of the governors present and voting shall bind the minority; and in case of equality of votes, the chairman shall have an additional vote or casting vote.

5. A special general meeting of the governors may at any time be called by direction of the president or of the Committee; or on the requisition of any twelve governors, provided the requisition be made in writing to the Secretary, and the purpose for which the same is summoned be published in three morning newspapers at least ten days prior to the next meeting; but the proceedings of such special general meeting, though acted upon *pro tempore*, shall not be deemed final, until confirmed by another general meeting.



6. No new rule or law shall be made, nor shall any existing rule or law be repealed or altered, until determined upon at a general meeting by a majority of governors present and voting, and until confirmed at a subsequent general or special meeting.

7. The presence of seven governors shall be necessary to constitute a quorum at general meetings, and without that number no business shall be transacted.

8. At the annual general meeting, a Committee for the management of the Institution shall be elected, consisting of the president, the vice-presidents, the treasurer, honorary secretary, and twenty-four other governors; four of which governors shall not have been members of the preceding Committee. They shall meet on the last Friday, or on such other day of every month as the Committee may appoint; and three members shall be necessary to constitute a meeting, and to transact business. A special meeting of the Committee may be called by the direction of the treasurer, or by any three members of the Committee, on giving at least three days' notice of the same, and specifying the business for which it is called.

9. The Committee shall have authority to appoint sub-committees, whose reports shall be submitted to their consideration; they shall elect all the officers, except the physicians of the Hospital and the honorary secretary, who shall be elected by the governors at large; and, with the assistance of the medical officers, shall form regulations and bye-laws for the internal management of the Hospital.

10. The resolutions of one meeting of the Committee shall not be rescinded by another, unless it be specially summoned for that purpose. All accounts, except such small sums as may be comprised under the item of petty cash, shall be submitted to the Committee at the monthly meetings, after having been duly examined by the secretary, the resident medical officer, and the house-directors; and such accounts, if approved, shall be paid by cheques payable to order, signed in Committee by the chairman and one other member, or, in case a Committee cannot be formed, by two of the house-directors, and in all cases countersigned by the secretary. All the larger articles of supply, when practicable, shall be furnished by contract made after public tender. No expenditure for repairs of premises or any machinery shall be incurred, without a written order from the Committee or house-directors.

11. The Committee shall yearly publish a report of the state of the Hospital.

12. No person being a member of the Committee shall furnish for profit any goods, provisions, or other articles, for the use of, or on account of, the Hospital, or be concerned in any contract for supplying the same, or be employed for hire, or wages, or profit, in any office or employment under the charity.

#### Treasurer.

13. The treasurer, if present, shall take the chair at all meetings of the Committee, in the absence of the president or vice-presidents. He shall keep an account at the bankers', and all moneys received for the use of the Hospital shall be paid to such account; he shall honour all cheques signed, as provided in Rule 10; and the signature of the secretary shall be a sufficient warranty that the

cheques purporting to be so signed are properly signed, and shall be an indemnity to the treasurer against risk.

### Auditors.

14. Three gentlemen shall be appointed annually at the meeting of the Committee in November, who shall audit the accounts of the Institution for the current year, and approve an abstract of all receipts and disbursements to be prepared by the secretary, and laid before the annual general meeting in February.

### Monthly Directors.

15. The Committee shall at their first meeting, in the month of February, elect three members of their own body to be directors of the Hospital, in addition to the trustees and two senior physicians, who shall be *ex officio* directors. And the Committee may appoint one of such directors to be the chairman, who shall retain his office for the ensuing twelve months, the Committee appointing the other directors, excepting the *ex officio* directors, monthly. Two of the directors to form a quorum.

16. They shall from time to time cause the beds, clothes, and apparel belonging to the Hospital to be examined, and shall report thereon, if necessary, to the Committee. They shall inspect the tradesmen's bills, and take care that the provisions, bedding, clothing, furniture, and every article for the use of the Hospital, be supplied on the most reasonable terms; they shall order in writing all permanent stores.

17. They shall be authorised in all respects to enforce the observance of the regulations of the Hospital; they shall notice and report to the Committee any irregularity or misconduct on the part of the officers, servants, or patients of the charity, and shall, at every meeting of the Committee, cause a statement of the house expenditure to be produced for the preceding month. They shall appoint the porters, nurses, and other menial servants of the Hospital, and dismiss them for misconduct.

17A. The chairman of the directors shall, during the intervals between their meetings, be authorised to exercise the functions of the directors in any matter of urgency, he reporting, at their next meeting, what he shall have done under this authority.

### Physicians.

18. There shall be two physicians and two assistant physicians, who shall be Fellows or Members (formerly called Licentiates) of the Royal College of Physicians of London; and also a consulting surgeon, who shall be a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons.

19. The physicians and assistant physicians shall be elected by the governors at large; and no governor shall be qualified to vote, unless he shall have become a governor three months before a vacancy is declared.

20. One of the physicians shall visit the Hospital at least once every day, and at such times as they may deem necessary. They shall have the power of dismissing any patient or convalescent for refractory conduct or disobedience of orders.



### Assistant Physicians.

21. In case of the illness or necessary absence of either of the physicians, one of the assistant physicians shall attend regularly in his stead. Such attendances are to be reported to the Committee.

### Hospital Pupils.

22. No medical student shall be permitted to visit the Hospital unless in company with one of the physicians, and unless he is regularly entered or registered as a pupil.

### Resident Medical Officer.

23. The resident medical officer shall reside constantly at the Hospital, and shall devote himself entirely to the duties of his office; and, previously to his election, he shall be required to produce satisfactory testimonials to the Committee.

24. He shall superintend the patients between the visits of the physicians, and the dispensary shall be exclusively under his control. In the absence of the Committee and house-directors, he shall be recognised as the head of the establishment.

25. Accurate registers of the patients admitted, as well as of the remedies employed for their recovery, shall be kept, which registers shall be the property of the Hospital; he shall produce a special report every month, to be laid before the Committee.

26. When the number of patients shall be great, a medical assistant shall be appointed by the house-directors, subject to the confirmation of the Committee, and he shall receive such remuneration as the Committee shall from time to time determine.

### Honorary Secretary.

27. There shall be an honorary secretary, who shall also be a member of the Committee, and chosen annually with them. He shall be at liberty to attend all deputations to public bodies and private persons. He shall communicate with persons concerning the affairs of the Hospital during the intervals between the monthly meetings of the Committee, and shall report to the Committee, at their next meeting, all special or important events that shall have occurred within his knowledge during the month. He shall also assist the treasurer in the discharge of his duties when necessary.

### Secretary and House Steward.

28. The duties of this officer shall be to reside in the Hospital, if required by the Committee, and, in the absence of the house-directors, to have the management of the domestic affairs of the Hospital, under the general superintendence of the resident medical officer. He shall be required to enter into a bond, with sufficient sureties, for the due and faithful performance of his duties. He shall also perform the several duties specified in the bye-laws.

### Matron.

29. The duties of the matron shall principally relate to the wards, the kitchen, and the laundry. She shall exercise a strict superintendence over the nurses

shall have the charge of linen, bedding, glass, crockery, and ordinary kitchen and scullery stores, subject to the general supervision of the house-steward; and shall visit every ward of the Hospital at least three times in the day. She shall also perform the several duties specified in the bye-laws.

#### Collector.

30. The duties of this officer shall be—

To call on subscribers and collect all donations and subscriptions of the Hospital; to give only authorised printed receipts for the same; to attend all meetings, when required; to keep correct lists and duplicate lists of all donations and subscriptions, with the residences of the donors and subscribers made up from day to day; to pay weekly all moneys he may receive to the bankers; to deliver weekly to the secretary reports in writing of all moneys received and paid, with the balance at the bankers; to keep the accounts regularly entered in the collector's cash book; to deliver a copy of the annual report to each subscriber; and to give such security, with sureties, for the due and faithful performance of his duties, as may be required.

#### Nurses.

31. The head nurse in each ward shall attend principally to the patients, and to the keeping of the wards clean and quiet.

32. The under nurses shall be under the direction of the head nurses, and shall perform the more menial offices of the Hospital.

#### Porter and Engineer.

33. The porter and the engineer shall be employed as the Committee or directors may think proper. They shall not absent themselves without the permission of the house-directors or resident medical officer.

#### Trustees.

34. The legal estate in the lands, buildings, and premises of the Hospital shall be vested in five trustees, new trustees being appointed when vacancies occur at a general meeting of the governors.

35. All legacies of £100 and upwards, unless otherwise directed by the testators, shall be invested for the benefit of the Hospital, in the names of three trustees, to be called trustees of the fund.

36. No variation in the usual gratuities and fixed salaries shall be made, unless the Committee be specially summoned for that purpose, and unless the proposed addition or diminution be confirmed by a subsequent Committee.

#### Bye-laws.

37. The bye-laws which shall from time to time be made by the Committee shall be open to the inspection of any subscriber, and shall contain, among other things, a full specification of the duties of the resident medical officer, the matron, and other officers of the Institution, with the practices usually adopted for their election; which specification shall be read out to every individual before his appointment, and referred to on all occasions of doubt.
