## HOSPITAL STAFF.



The Eighty-sixth Annual Meeting of the Members, Patrons, Subscribers and Friends of the Liverpool Dental Hospital (being the thirty-fifth since incorporation), held on Thursday, 17th April, 1947, at the Town Hall, Liverpool.

The Lord Mayor (Alderman W. G. Gregson, J.P.) in the Chair.
The Annual Report for the year ending December 31st, 1946, was read by Mr. C. W. Hesketh (Hon. Secretary), and the Balance Sheet and Accounts to December 3lst 1946, by Mr. J. Forster Brakell (Hon. Treasurer).

Moved by the Lord Mayor, seconded by Professor H. H. Stones, and carried :
"That the Report and Statement of Accounts now be adopted."

Moved by Mr. J. W. Tomlinson, seconded by Mr. J. V. Murphy, and carried :
"That the thanks of the Meeting be given to the President, Chairman, Committee, Honorary Auditor, Honorary Treasurer and Honorary Secretary, and to the Consulting Physician, Consulting Surgeon, and the Dental Staff for their valuable services during the past year, and that the President, Officers, Committee and Hospital Staff for the year 1946, consisting of the following gentlemen (see list) and that Mr. A. H. Walker be re-elected Honorary Auditor."

Moved by Mr. Alfred S. Cross (Chairman of the Hospital): "That the best thanks of this Meeting be accorded to the Lord Mayor, for his kindness in presiding on this occasion."

## EIGHTY-SIXTH ANNUAL REPORT.

(Being the Thirty-fifth since the Incorporation of the Hospital).

The Chairman and Committee have pleasure in presenting their Eighty-sixth Annual Report and Statement of Accounts for the year ended December 31st, 1946.

During the past year the total number of attendances was 52,202, including 21,036 new patients, an increase of $\mathbf{3 , 0 0 8}$ on 1945. The number of operations performed was 45,422 , as compared with the 1945 figure of $\mathbf{4 2 , 7 7 2}$. The foregoing figures show that greater demands have been made upon the Hospital and it is gratifying to report that, in spite of the shortage of space and difficulties in securing staff, these demands have been met.

During the year 1947, in conjunction with the University of Liverpool School of Dental Surgery, a number of additional appointments will be made to the full-time Dental Staff. The grant of $£ 1,000$ from the Merseyside Hospitals Council towards these appointments is acknowledged with gratitude.

The Hospital Dental Aid Fund has enabled many deserving patients to obtain dentures, and the Committee's thanks are due to the Executive of the J. R. Hobhouse Dental Aid Fund for a further grant of $£ 150$.

The Dental Hospital has continued to co-operate with the School of Dental Surgery in the investigation into the causes of Dental Decay and its prevention. Research work is being continued at the National Children's Home, Frodsham, thanks to the generosity of Mr. J. P. Bibby and Messrs. J. Bibby \& Sons, Ltd.

The adjacent property, 65a-7la, Pembroke Place, was purchased in 1945, to provide for the development of the services and amenities the Hospital wishes to extend to the patients. Plans and specifications have, therefore, been prepared, and it is the desire of the Committee to adapt these premises for the use of the Hospital. In addition, the present building will in some respects be re-adapted to give additional clinic facilities. Together with the reinstatement of War Damage the Scheme will cost approximately $£ 15,000$. Sincere thanks are expressed to those who, by subscriptions, donations and gifts, have encouraged those working for the Hospital. The following are the larger donations :

From April Ist, 1948, the Hospital will be governed under the National Health Service Act, 1946, but until that date it will
continue on a voluntary basis. The year 1947 will be the 87th year since the foundation of the Hospital and it should, therefore, be recorded that throughout its long history the Hospital has met the needs of those requiring its services.

This record of service is due to those who during the years have given generously to the funds of the Hospital, and thanks are extended for this support, which has always been of great encouragement to the Committee.
