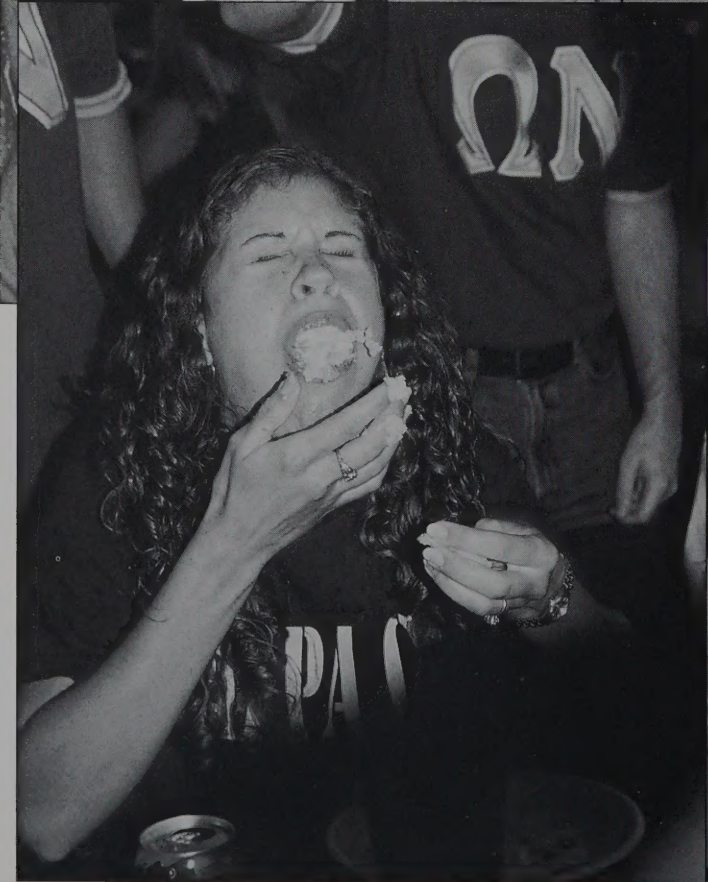

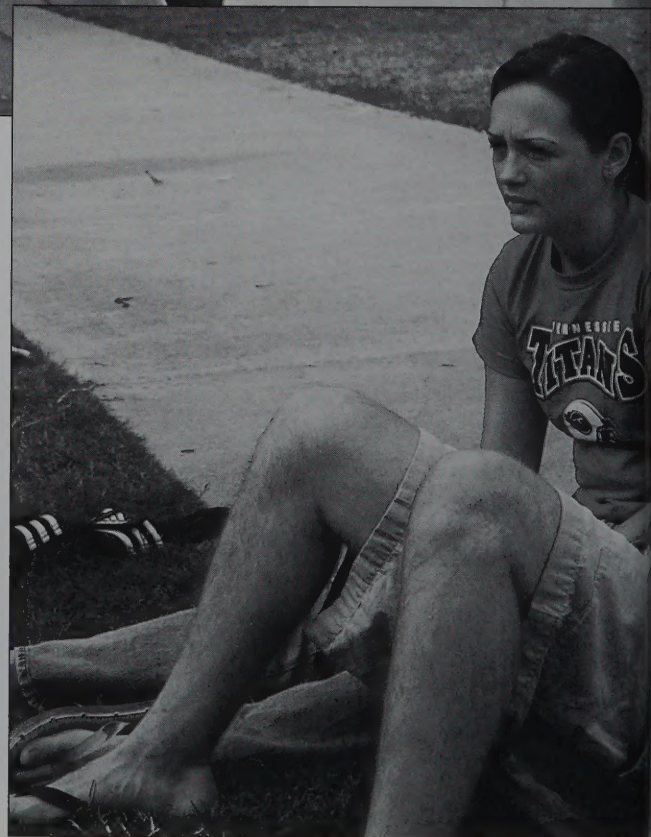

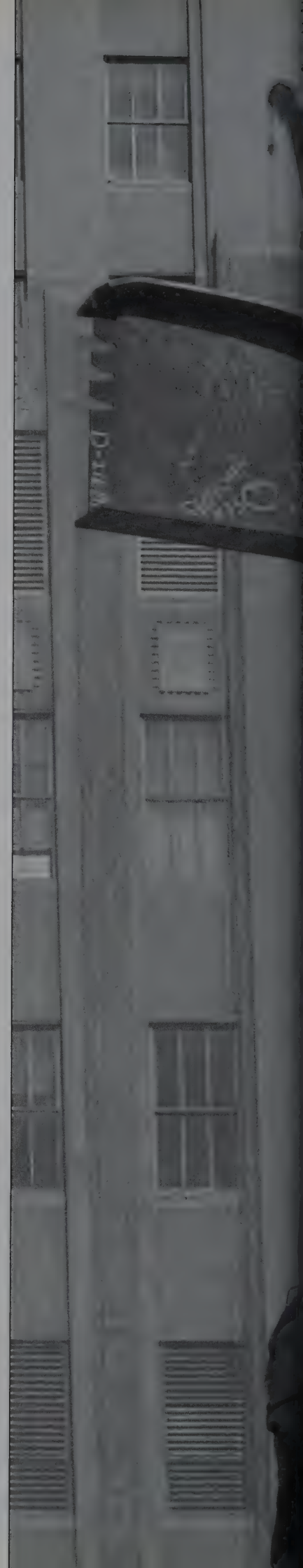

America," and tears ran down our cheeks when we recited those heart-breaking words,

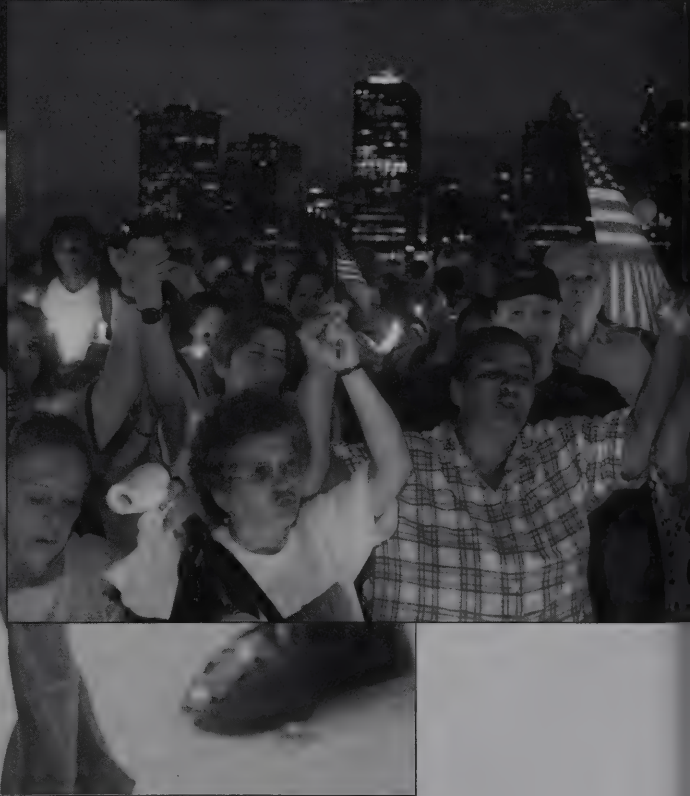
Bless

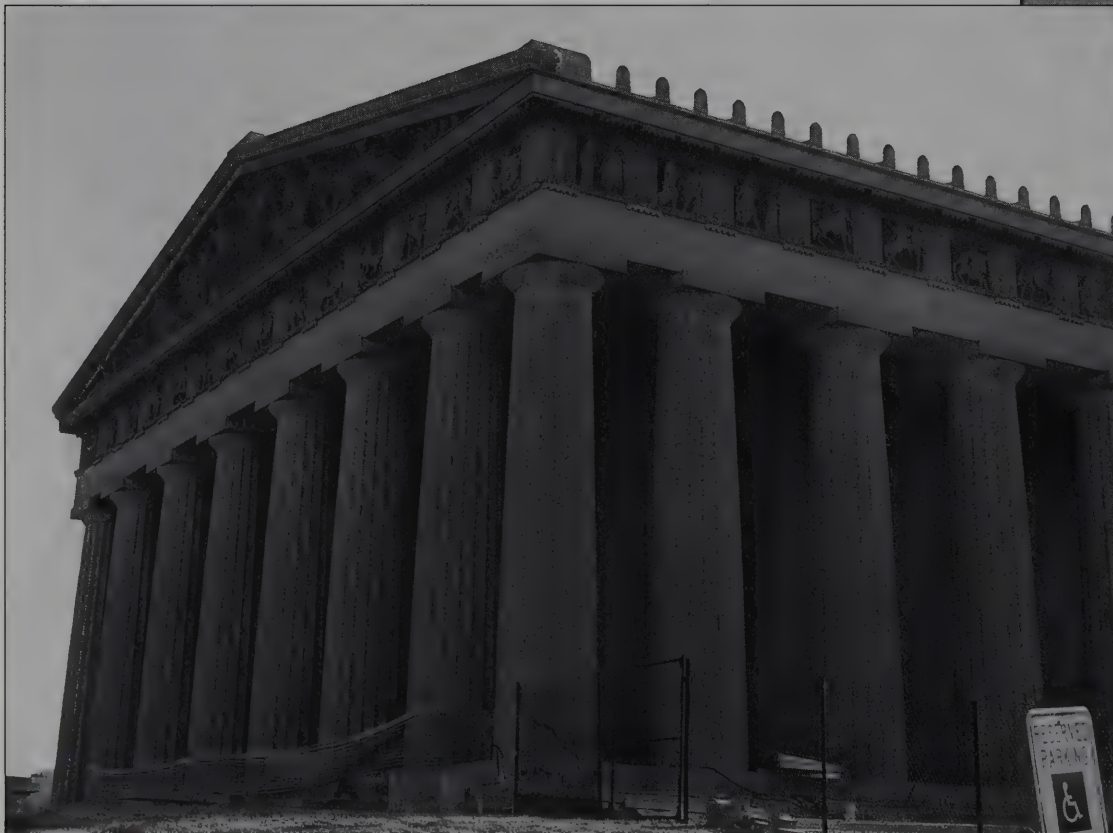

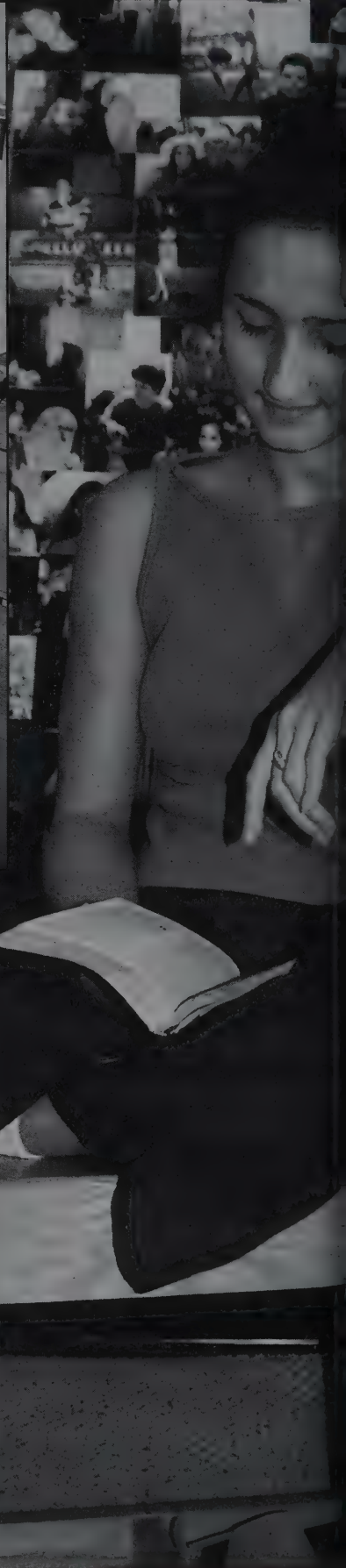

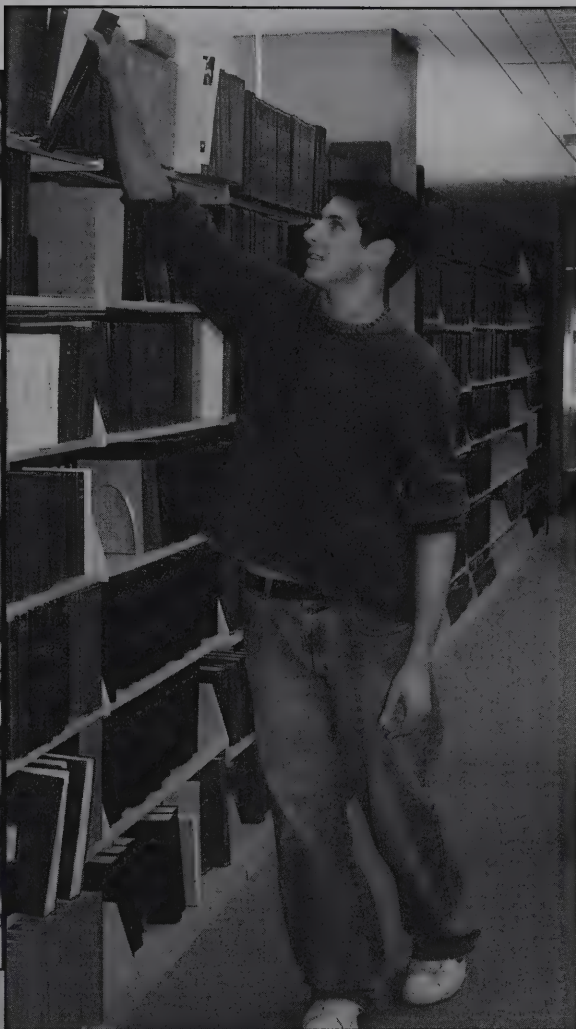
So much to do,

Having a car is often considered an important factor of college life. It is no different at Lipscomb. Driving, however, quickly became an inconvenience as the student body grew, and the parking lots did not. High Rise and Johnson's parking problems were solved as ample parking space was provided with the addition on a new parking garage. This garage was constructed along with the new Allen Arena. It not only provides parking for students, but also for the fans who come to watch Lipscomb's athletic events. Freshman Chris Wright says, "The parking area behind my dorm, High Rise, is very spacious and easily accessible." As far as Elam and Fanning are concerned, parking was scarce. Some people have described driving around campus for an half hour or more looking for a place to park. As always when dealing with a scarcity of parking spaces, students tended to make their own. The only problem was that some of these homemade parking spaces were located in fire lanes or next to fire hydrants. As a result, parking tickets were abundant. Freshman Nick Heffington was a recipient of one of these tickets. He said, "It was the first week of school and I parked my car right next to some other car, but later when I received the ticket, I was told that I was parked in front of a fire hydrant. There was no usual yellow curb, so I figured it was fine to park there." He now knows that it is better to find a real parking spot than to pay the \$50 fine. Administration felt that students should use the day student parking for addition parking spaces, but many of the female dorm residents felt it was unsafe to park there and then walk the distance to their dorms during the night. A solution was never found for the parking issues, it was just accepted that that is the price a student has to pay for the freedom of having a car.



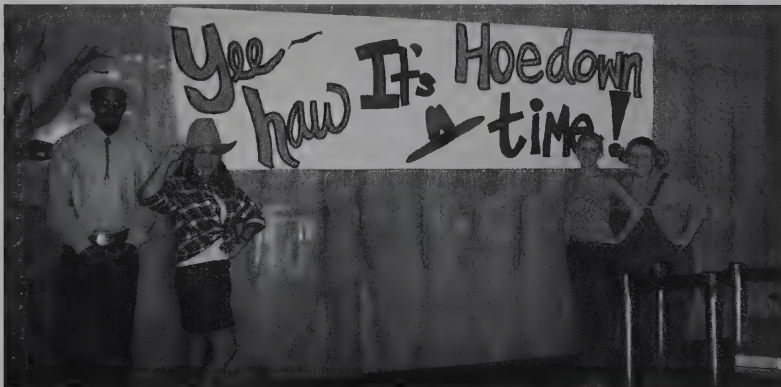

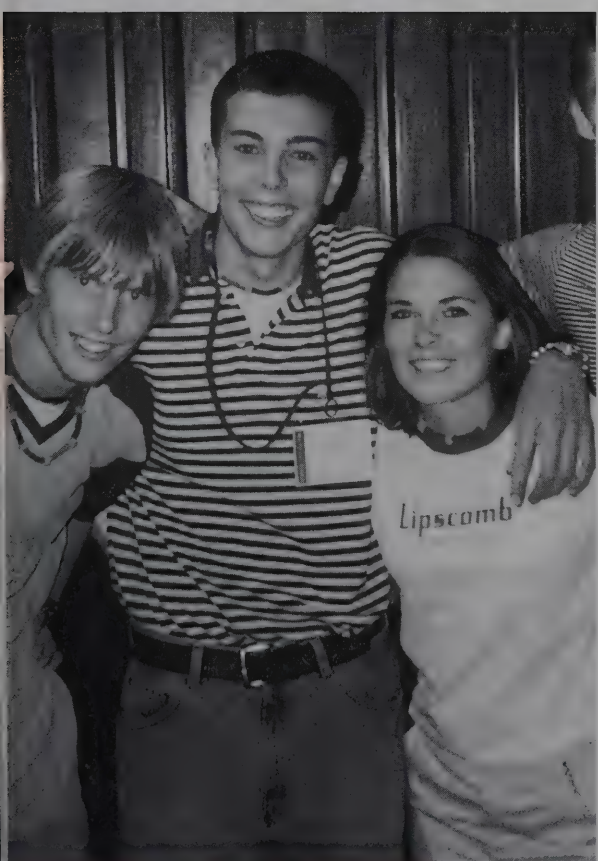

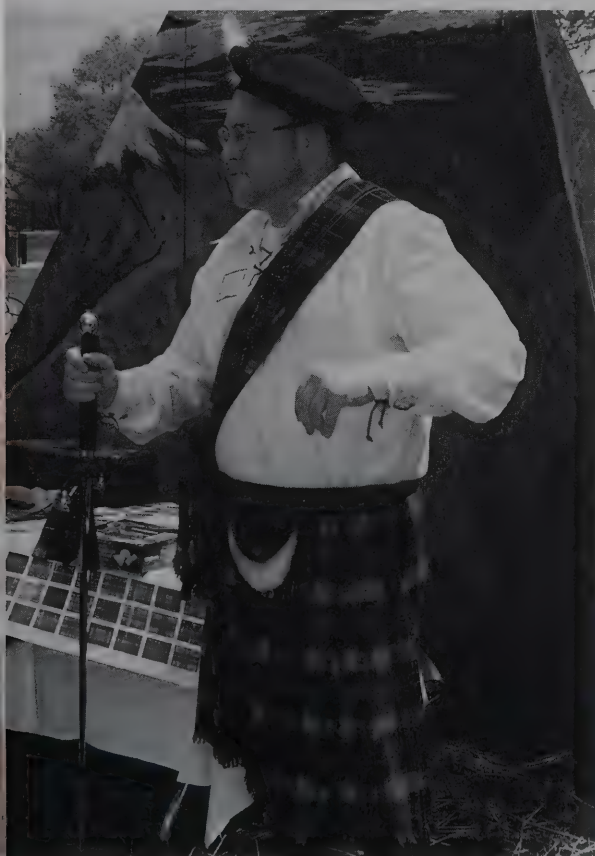


International

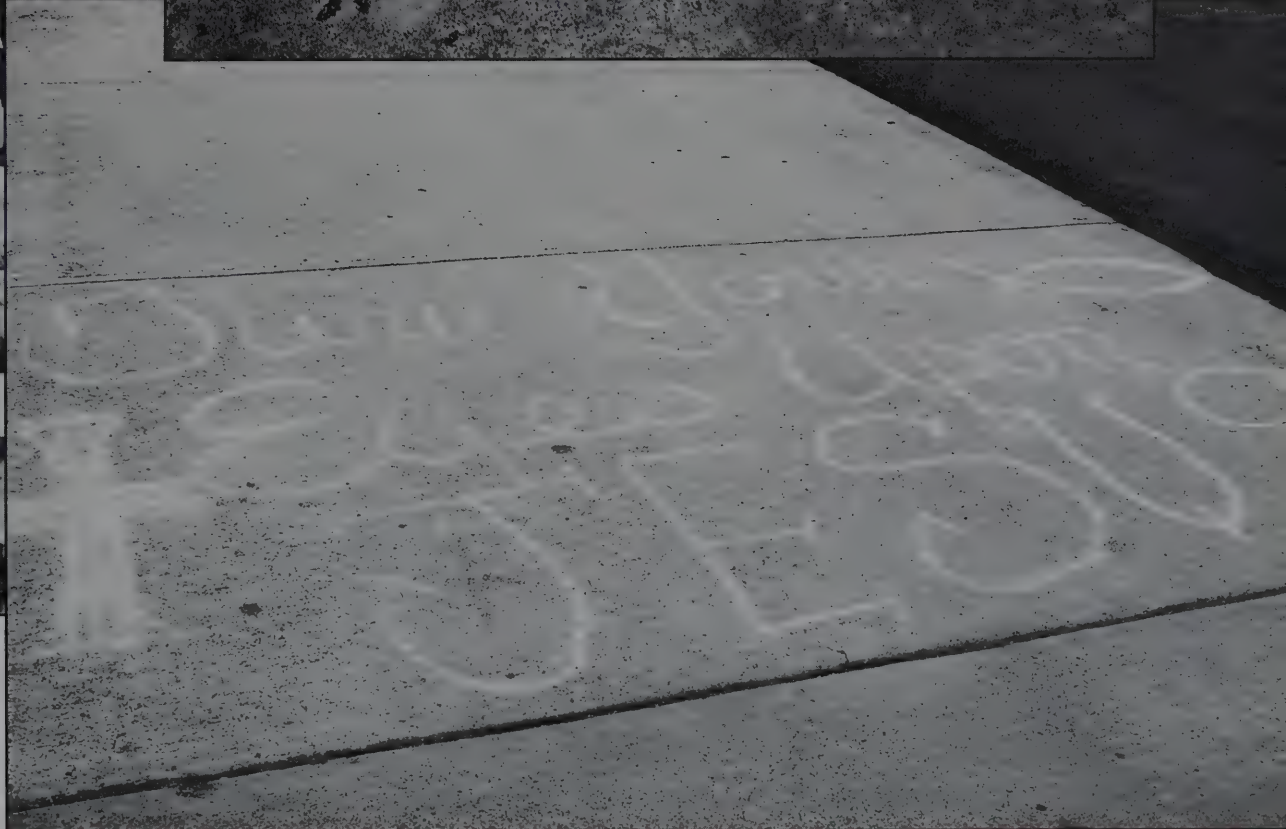
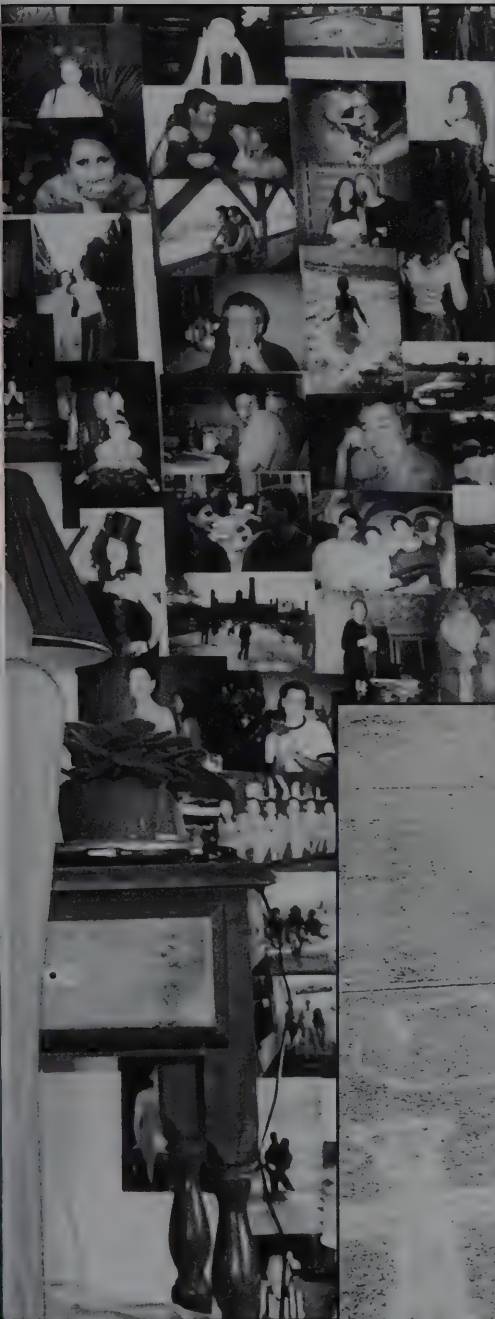

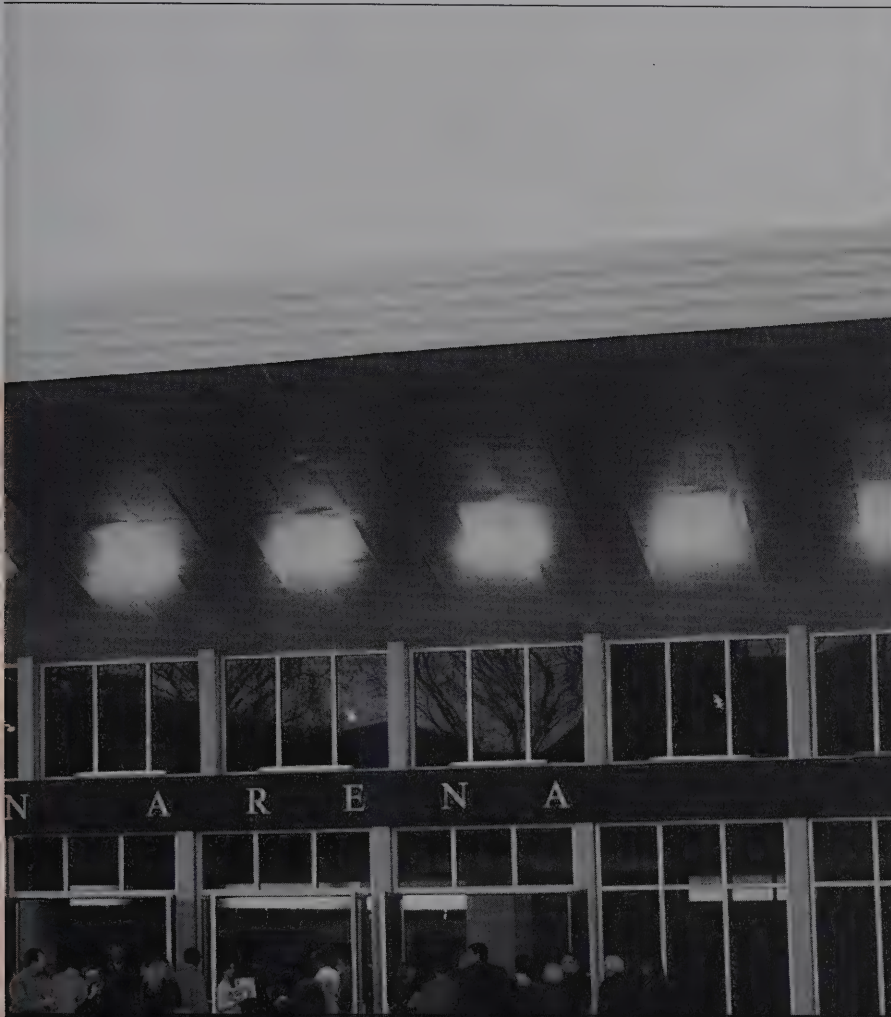
The dedication of Allen Arena

Delta NaNaNa went patriotic as it continued its homecoming tradition

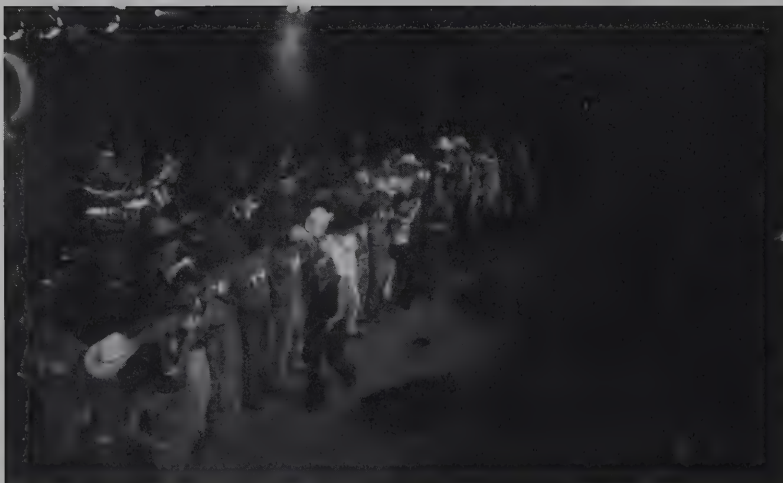

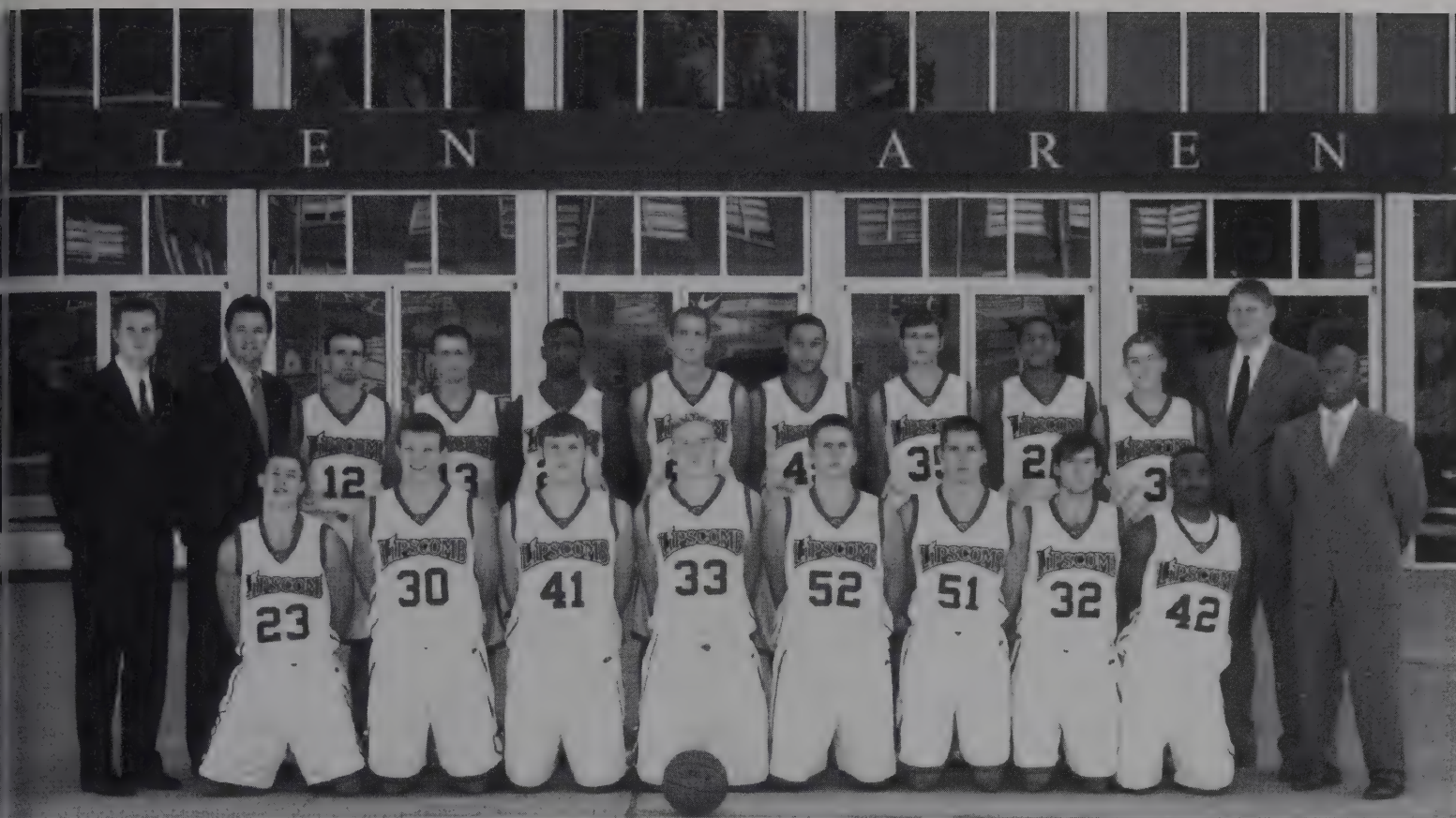
Athletics

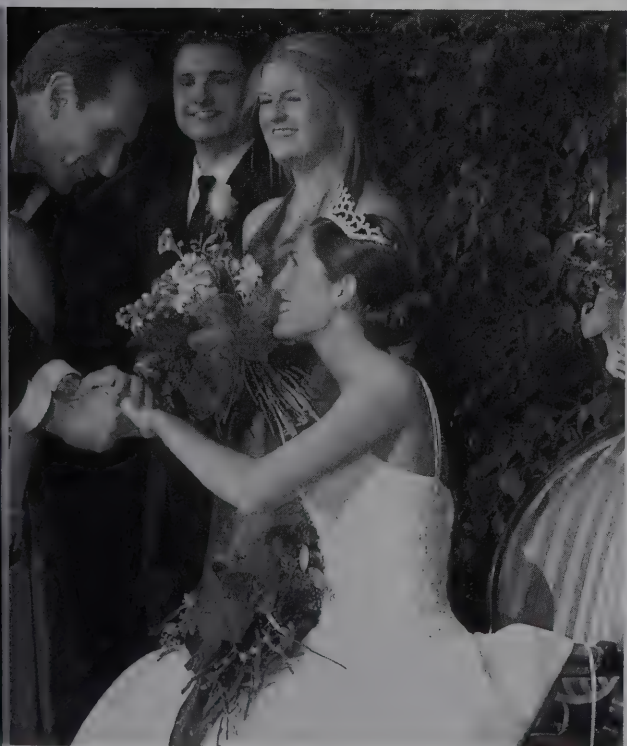


Homecoming

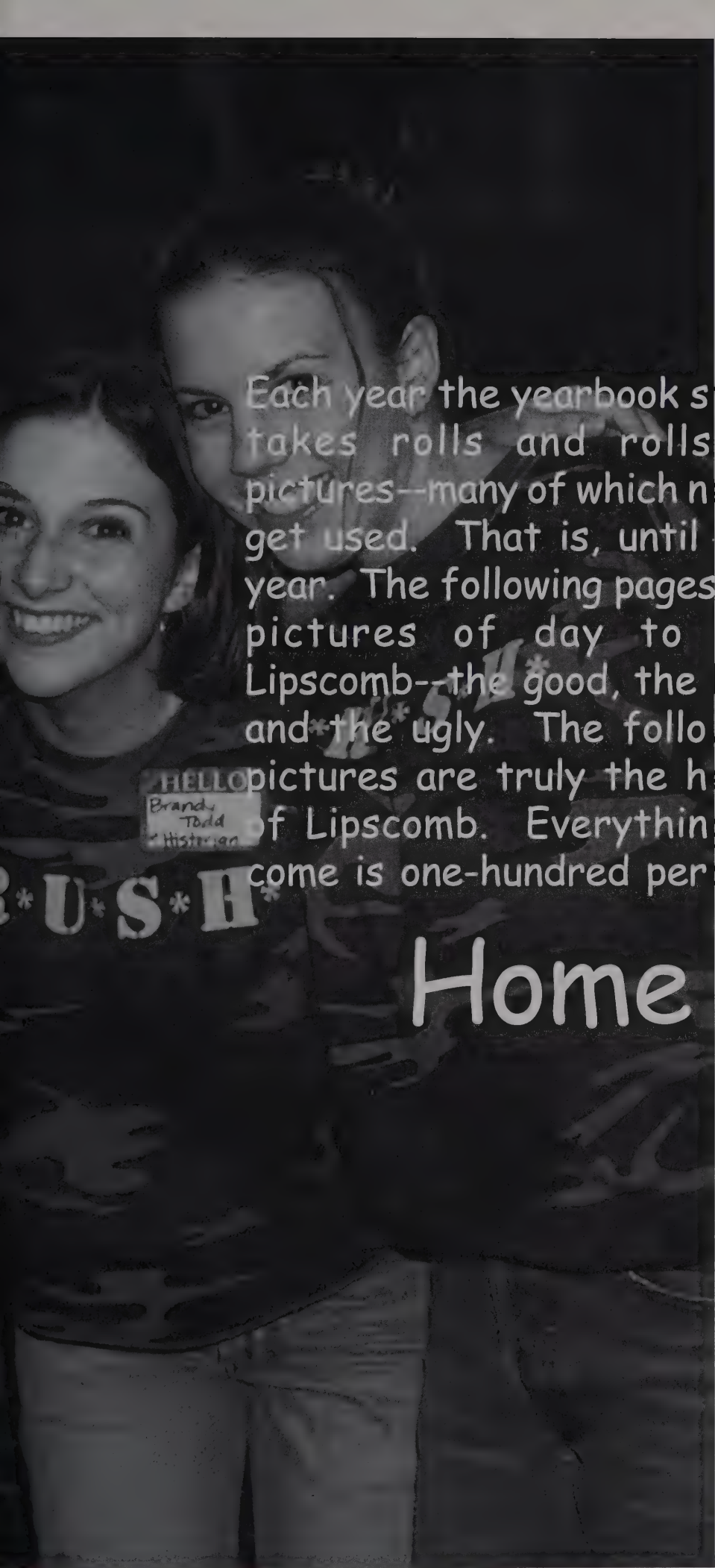
Missions

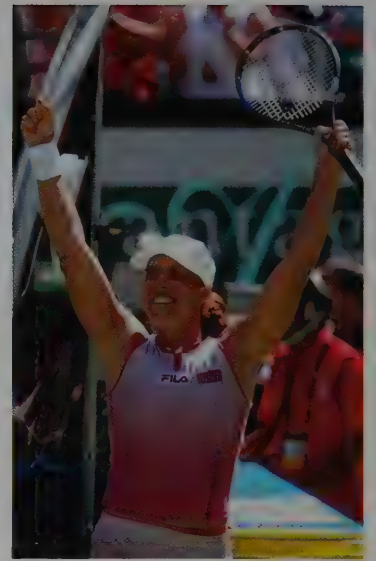

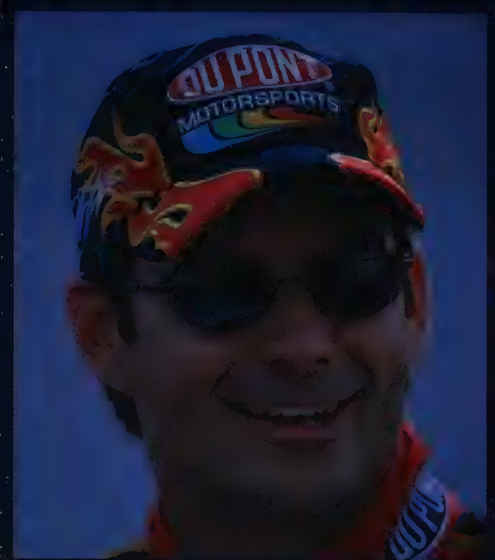

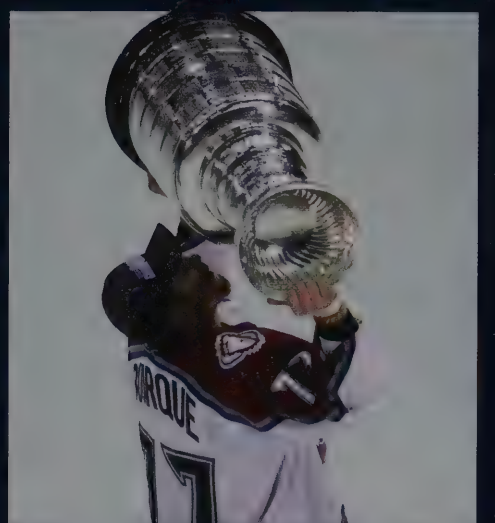
