Letter from the EDITORS

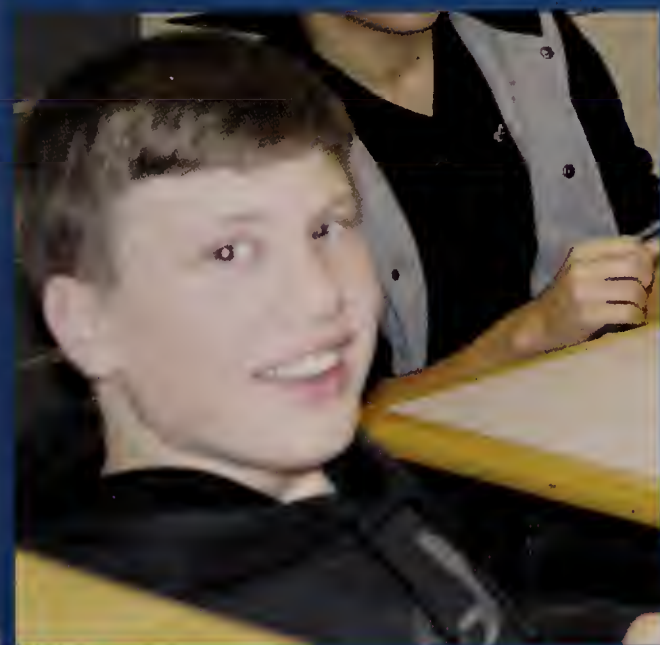
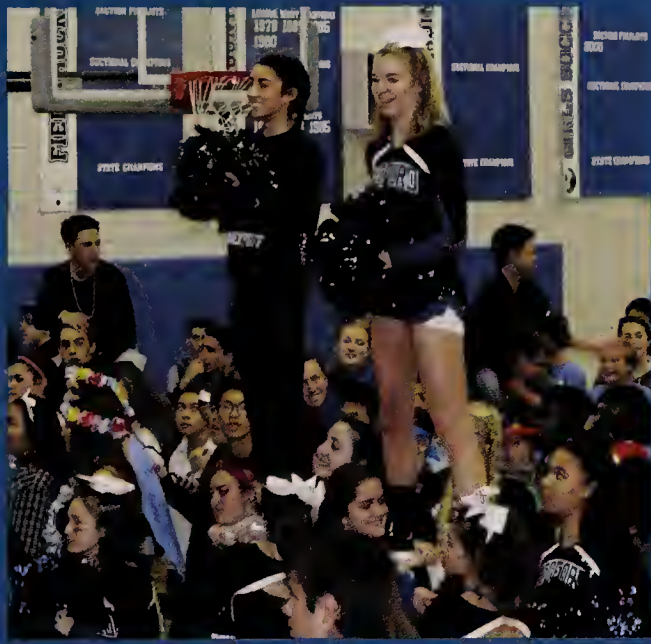

#metoo: The New York Times published a story alleging decades of sexual assault and harassment allegations against movie mogul Harvey Weinstein by dozens of actresses. With the producer's actions in mind, two words began to dominate social media in mid-October: "Me Too." The #MeToo movement, which was started a decade ago by activist Torano Burke, was given new life by actress Alyssa Milano in response to the former Miramax mogul's sexual misconduct scandal. On Oct. 15, the actress tweeted a message that read, "Suggested by a friend: If all the women who have been sexually harassed or assaulted write 'Me too' as a status, we might give people a sense of the magnitude of the problem." She then wrote "Me too" and tweeted, "If you've been sexually harassed or assaulted write 'me too' as a reply to this tweet." Within 24 hours "#MeToo" had been posted and commented on 12 million times. "A moment can create a movement. This is our moment. This is our movement. #MeToo," Alyssa wrote

Since May 2017, a Special Counsel investigation has been led by the current Special Counsel, former FBI Director Robert Mueller, into Russian interference in the 2016 United States elections including exploring any links or coordination between Donald Trump's 2016 presidential campaign and the Russian government. Several members of the Trump campaign and administration have been convicted or indicted as a result of the investigation, including Michael Flynn, George Papadopoulos, Rick Gates, and Paul Manafort.

RUSSIA INVESTIGATION



The high-profile sexual assault trial in which Bill Cosby faced off against one of his dozens of accusers ended in a mistrial on June 17 after a Pennsylvania jury stayed hopelessly deadlocked, unable to come to a unanimous decision. The jury deliberated for six days before a judge announced the mistrial (reports claimed that two of the 12 jurors could not find him guilty). In the middle of all of this, the defense asked for a mistrial, but the judge refused to grant one and told the jury to keep talking it out to try to reach a "guilty" or "not guilty" verdict. The legendary funnyman, whose reputation is all but shot, was charged with three counts of aggravated indecent assault against Andrea Constand. He now faces a retrial in spring 2018. Constand is but one of many women who came forward about Cosby's crimes: He has been accused by 59 women of rape, drug-facilitated sexual assault, sexual battery, or other sexual misconduct. The earliest alleged incidents took place in the mid-1960s, with the rest scattered all the way until the latest in 2008.

COSBY TRIAL



Since becoming president, Donald Trump engaged in an escalating war of words with Kim Jong-un, trading personal insults and threats of military strikes and raising concerns about an outbreak of hostilities. Towards the end of his Asia tour, he sent a tweet from Hanoi that took the verbal jousting to a new level, taunting the North Korean leader over his height and weight. "Why would Kim Jong-Un insult me by calling me 'old,' when I would NEVER call him 'short and fat'?" he tweeted. North Korean state media proclaimed in response, "He should know that he is just a hideous criminal sentenced to death by the Korean people."

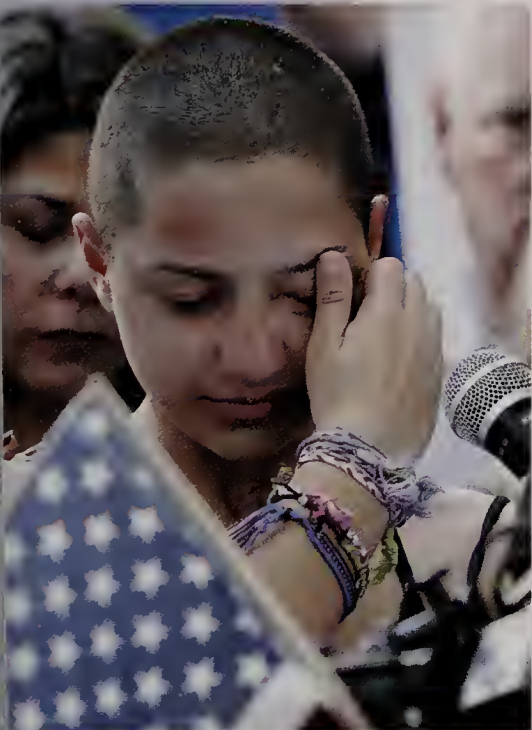

2017-2018 marked the worst year of mass shootings in modern U.S. history, with two of the five deadliest attacks in the country's history happening within 35 days of each other. On October 1, 2017, a gunman opened fire on 22,000 people at a country music festival from his hotel suite on the 32nd floor of the Mandalay Bay hotel on the Las Vegas strip. The attack, which left 58 people dead and more than 500 injured, marked the deadliest mass shooting in modern U.S. history. Just one month after the tragic attack in Las Vegas, a 26-year-old gunman killed 26 churchgoers and injured 20 others at the First Baptist Church in Sutherland Springs, Texas. On February 14, 2018, an expelled student invaded the campus of Marjory Staneman Douglas in Parkland, FL. He killed 17 students and wounded dozens more. Immediately following the attack at their school, students from MSD began a campaign on social media, leading to a national movement for gun reform. "For survivors of the Staneman Douglas shooting, by survivors of the Staneman Douglas shooting" using the hashtag NeverAgain, the group staged protests demanding legislative action be taken to prevent similar shootings in the future and locally condemned U.S. lawmakers who have received political contributions from the National Rifle Association (NRA).

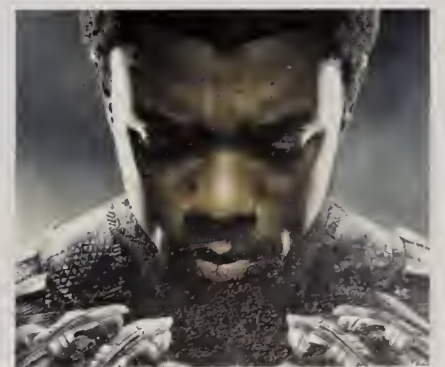
IPHONEX



The 10th anniversary Apple iPhone was released. Called the iPhone X (pronounced "iPhone Ten"), the phone cost \$1,000. It was available in limited stock at Apple stores, carriers, and retailers on November 3, with most online sites and retailers selling out within 30 minutes of release.

EVENTS THAT MARKED THE SCHOOL YEAR

Black Panther was released theatrically in the United States on February 16, 2018, in 2D, 3D, IMAX and other premium large formats. The film received praise for its visuals, screenplay, characters, direction, performances, costume design, soundtrack, and action sequences. It has grossed over \$763 million worldwide, making it the highest-grossing film of 2018. Its four-day opening weekend gross of \$242.2 million in the United States was the second-highest of all-time and its three-day gross of \$202 million was the fifth highest of all time, as well as the biggest debut by an African-American director.



BLACK PANTHER



Wonder Woman, starring Gal Gadot and directed by Patty Jenkins, premiered in Shanghai on May 15, 2017, and was released in the United States on June 2, 2017, in 2D, 3D and IMAX 3D. It received largely positive reviews from critics, being praised for the direction, performances, action sequences and musical score. The film set numerous box office records; it is the fifth-highest-grossing superhero film domestically and 20th-highest-grossing film in the United States. It's ranked as #1 on the Rotten Tomatoes list of 50 best superhero movies of all time.

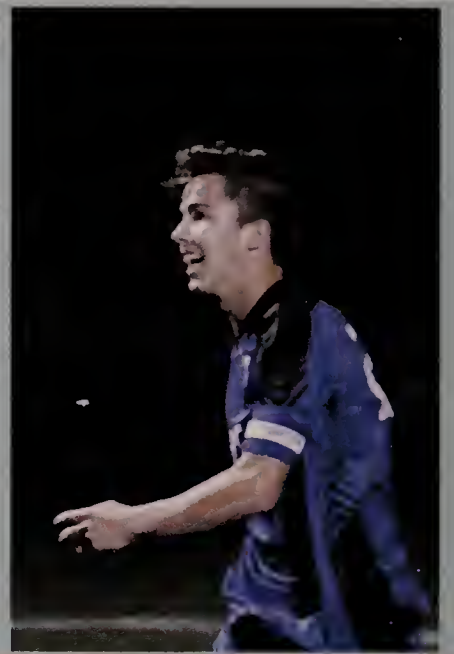
