

As leisure time increases and competition for available recreational resources becomes more keen, total recreational community developments have begun to proliferate.

These developments offer lot sales, condominiums, or recreational vehicle campsites to the purchaser.

In addition, an assortment of recreational opportunities are made available to the purchaser, ranging from golf courses, clubhouses, lakes, swimming pools and other "built" recreational amenities to planned recreational programs, social directors and 24 hour guard patrol.

Such projects have been developing in sufficient numbers and varieties to have attracted the attention of state and federal agencies and of students of planning and of recreation.

However, we have not yet found a bibliography concentrated on this field and so offer the following as a first foray in this direction.




