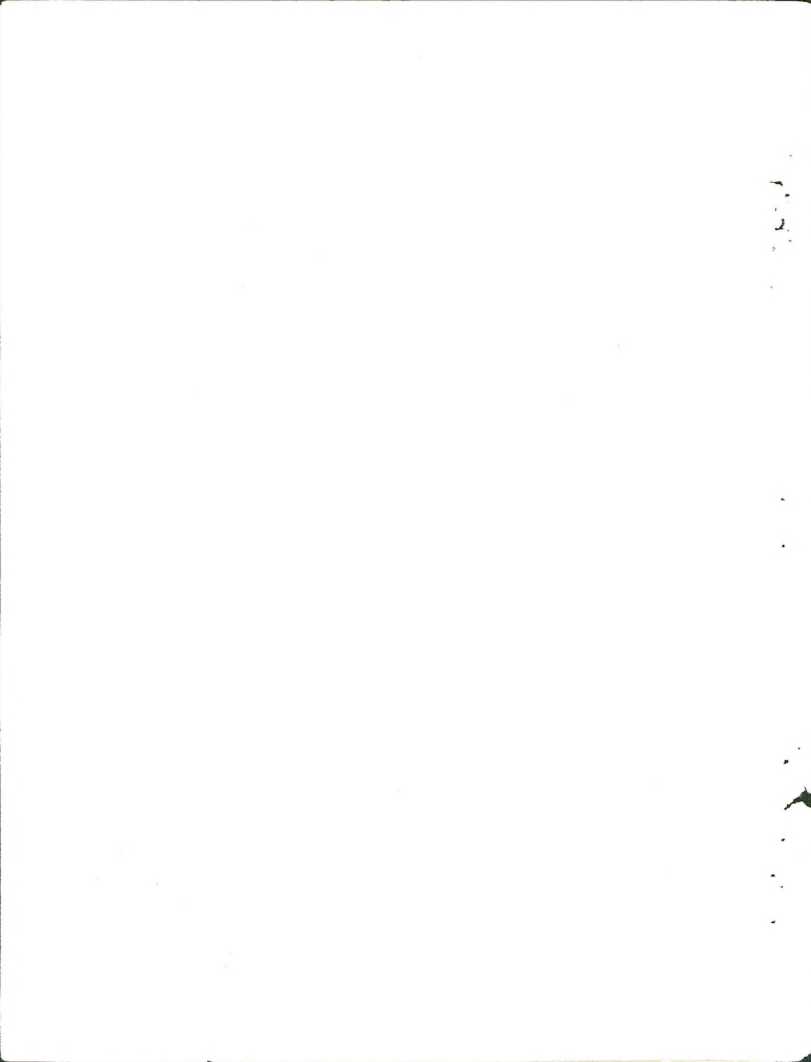

Introduction

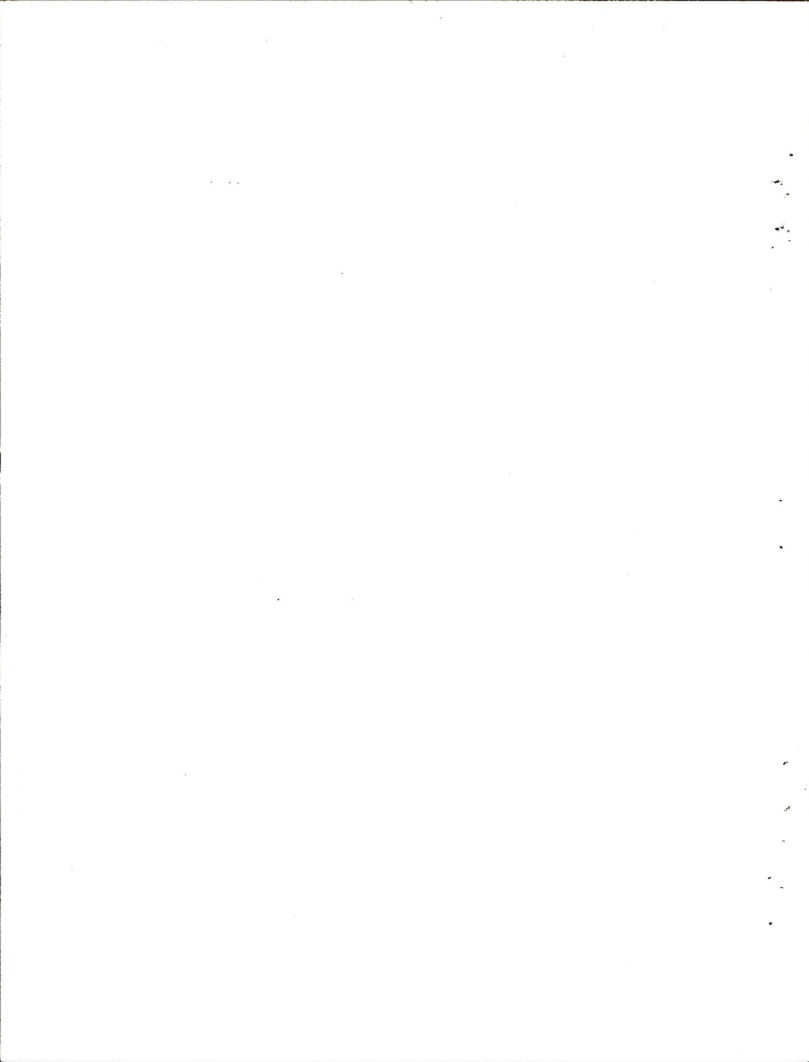
Riparian areas and the multitude of impacts, uses, and values that affect them have become of high interest to the Bureau of Land Management and our sister land-managing agencies. Prior to 1977, very little information dealing with riparian issues had been published. Beginning in that year, interest and reports accelerated. It has been estimated that by mid-1986, there will be approximately 1,500 scientific references covering the various riparian topics.

The BLM in Idaho and the other western states has initiated programs to improve their management of riparian areas. To assist with these programs, existing knowledge and techniques should be used to identify major problem areas and to avoid duplication of efforts. Unfortunately, most of the existing riparian reports have been published at workshops and symposia. Proceedings of these meetings have not been widely circulated and may be unavailable to most BLM specialists. The 270 references included in this bibliography were selected for Idaho and adjacent areas of the Intermountain West or have broad, Bureau-wide applications.

This bibliography is in the traditional style of reference listing, subject index, and author index. Abstracts are not included, but all references are on file at the Idaho State Office (Allan Thomas - 931). Abstracts and/or copies can be supplied upon request.

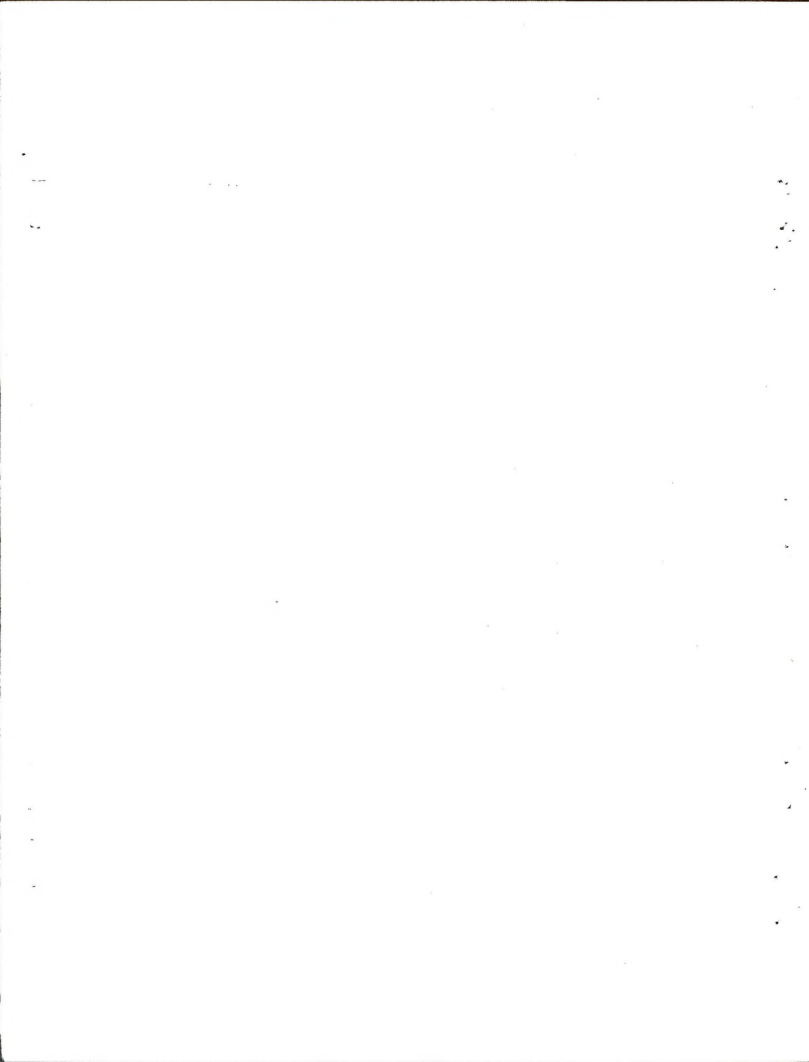
An even more useful form of the bibliography is being developed by Cheryl Wentzell. These same references have been entered into an IBM computer using a USDA program called FAMULUS. This program has the advantages of sorting references by some twenty different "fields", can include abstracts, and can have newer references added at any time. We are now exploring the options of: (1) converting the FAMULUS program for use on BLM's Honeywell or Level 6 systems so that each district or detached area office can utilize the materials, (2) adapting the program for personal computers, and (3) adapting the material to the REX/ASPEN program. Results of these attempts should be available shortly along with a user's guide for obtaining the desired information.

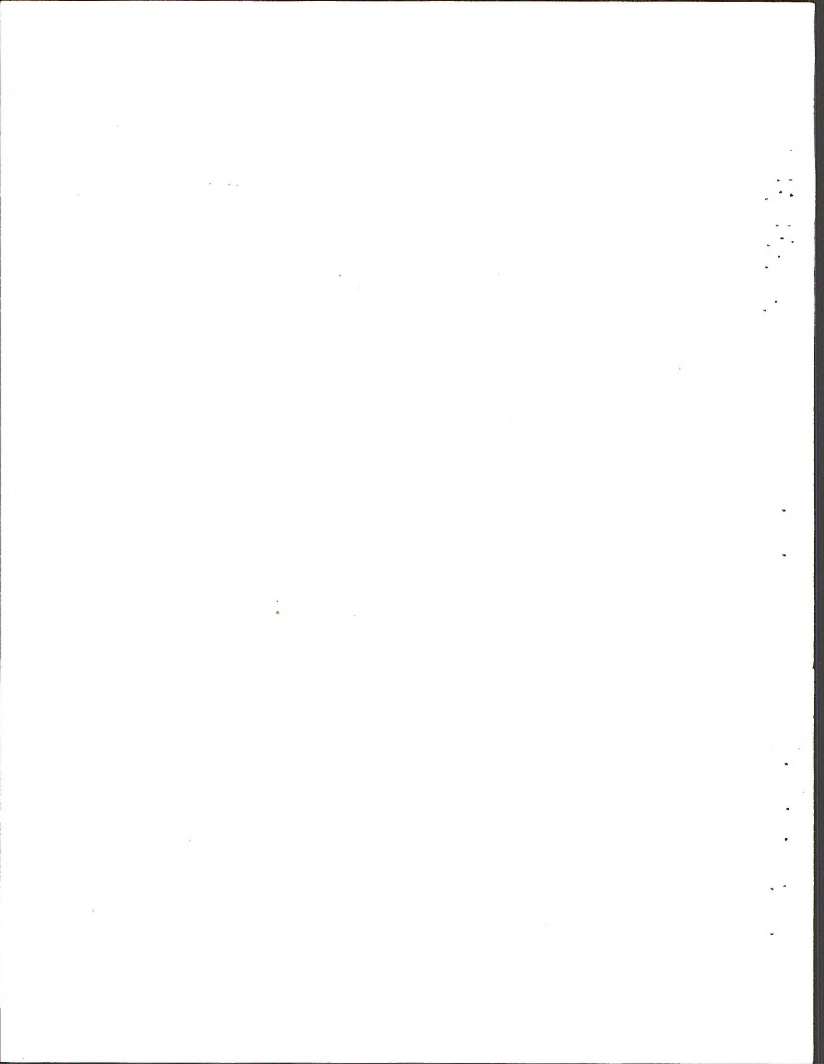

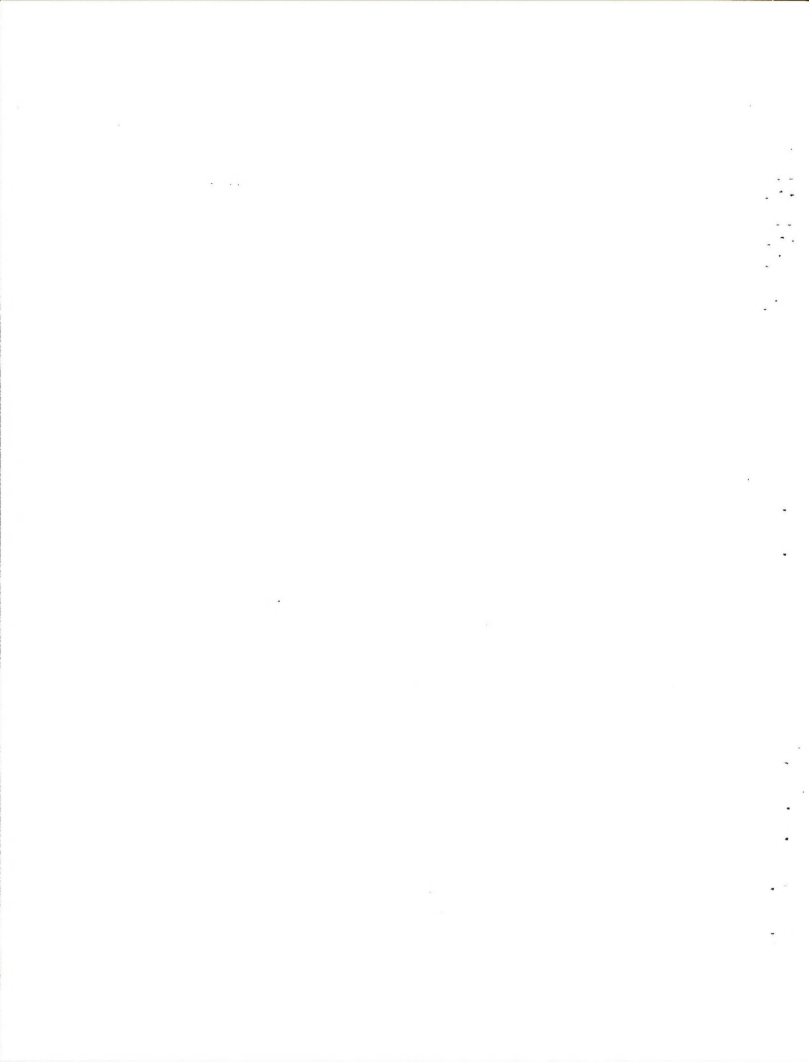

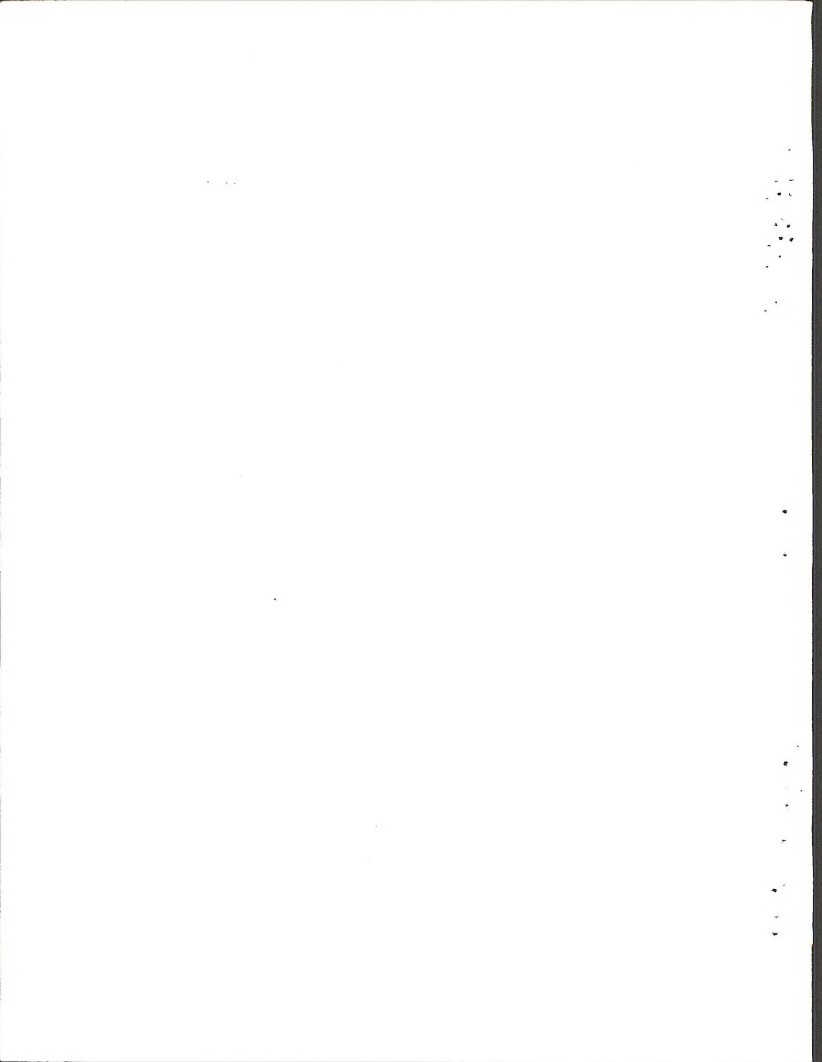
