



BILL OF MORTALITY

FOR THE SOCIETY OF FRIENDS IN DOVER N. H.

From 1708 to 1791, as taken from their Records.

THE Town of Dover at the beginning of this Bill of Mortality, had much more territory than it now has ; and it is not improbable that the places of residence of many of those whose deaths are here recorded, are now found out of the limits of what is at present called Dover.

This bill throws but little of that light upon the subject, that is naturally expected from a Bill of Mortality, as there is not a single disease mentioned in the whole 83 years ; neither do we suppose we have a record of all the Deaths that happened during that period.

It is to be wished that the Friends would keep a correct Bill of Mortality for each year, noting the time of their death, their names, diseases (which may be easily obtained in general) and their ages.— If they will comply with our wishes, it will be a pleasure to themselves and instructive to individuals.

GENERAL BILL OF MORTALITY FOR DOVER.

From Dr. Belknap's, History of N. H.

IN May 1735, that disease, which has received the popular name of *Throat distemper*, first made its appearance in this country at Kingston N. H.—of the first 40 that had it all died.—In Hampton-falls,, 20 families buried all their children ; 27 persons were lost out of 5 families, and in 14 months ending 26th July 1736, 210 persons died with this disease, being more than one sixth part of the inhabitants !—During this same period of 14 months 88 persons died of this pestilence in Dover, and in 15 Towns in the province of N. H. upwards of a thousand !
