9 added by section 405 of the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Balanced Budget Refinement Act of 1999, as enacted into law by section 1000(a)(6) of Public Law 106-113) is amended-(1) in the matter preceding subclause (I)— 5 6 (A) by striking "for its cost reporting period beginning during 1999 is paid on the basis 7 of the target amount applicable to the hospital 8 under subparagraph (C) and that"; and 9 (B) by striking "such target amount" and 10 inserting "the target amount otherwise applica-12 ble to the hospital under subparagraph (C) (referred to in this clause as the 'subparagraph 13 (C) target amount')"; and 14 (2) in subclause (I), by striking "target amount 15 16 otherwise applicable" and all that follows through "target amount")" and inserting "subparagraph (C) 17 target amount". 18

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by this section shall apply as if included in the enactment of the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Balanced Budget Refinement Act of 1999, as enacted into law by section 23 1000(a)(6) of Public Law 106–113.
