

# YOUNG CHILD'S

2 Question. CAN you tell me, child, who made you?

Answer The great Goo, who made heaven and earth.

- 2 2. What doth Goo, do for you?
- A. He keeps me from harm by night and by day, and is always doing me good.
- 3 2. And what must you do for this great God who is so good to you?

- A. I must learn to know him first, and then I must do every thing to please him.
- 42. Where doth Gop teach us to know him and to please him?
- A. In his holy word, which is contained in the Bible.
- 5.2. Have you learned to know who
- A. God is a spirit; and though we cannot see him, yet he sees and knows all things, and he can do all things.
- 62. What must you do to please
- A. I must do my duty both towards Gop and towards man,
  - 72. What is your duty to Gop?

A. My duty to Gon, is to fear and honour him, to love and ferve him, to pray to him, and to praise him.

8 2. What is your duty to man?

A. My duty to man, is to obey my parents, to speak the truth always, and to be honest and kind to all.

92 What good do you hope for by feeking to please Gon?

A. Then I shall be a child of Goo, and have Goo for my father and my friend for ever.

10 2. And what if you do not fear God, nor love him, nor feek to please him?

A. Then I shall be a wicked child, and the great Goa will be angry with me.

- 11 2. Why are you afraid of Gon's anger?
- A. Because he can kill my body, and he can make my soul miserable after my body is dead.

- A. Yes, I fear I have too often finned against God, and deserved his anger.
- 13 2 What do you mean by finning against Gop?
- A. To fin against Gon, is to do any thing that God forbids me, or not to do what Gon commands me.
- ved from the anger of God which your fins have deserved?
  - A. I must be forry for my fins, I must

pray to God to forgive me what is past, and serve him better for the time to come.

15 2. Will God forgive you if you pray for it?

A. I hope he will forgive me, if I trust in his mercy, for the sake of what Jesus Christ has done, and what he has suffered.

16 2. Do you know who Jesus Christis?

17 2. What has CHRIST done towards. the faving of men?

A. He obeyed the law of Goo himfolf, and hath taught us to obey it alfo.

- 18 2. And what has CHRIST suffered in order to save men?
- A. He died for finners who have broke the law of GoD, and who deferved to die themselves.
  - 19 2. Where is JESUS CHRIST now?
- A. He is alive again, and gone to heaven, to provide a place there for all that serve Gon and love his Son Jesus.
- 20 2. Can you of yourfelf love and ferve God and Christ?
- A. No, I cannot do it of myself; but Gon will help me by his own spirit if I ask him for it.
- 21 2. Will Jesus CHRIST ever come again?
- A. CHRIST will come again, and call me and all the world to account for what we have done.

22. For what purpose is this account to be given?

A. That the children of Gop, as well as the wicked, may all receive according to their works.

23 2. What must become of you if you are wicked?

A. If I am wicked I shall be sent down to everlasting fire in hell among wicked and miserable creatures.

24 2. And whither will you go if you are a child of Gop?

A. If I am a child of God I shall be taken up to heaven, and dwell there with God and CHRIST for ever.
