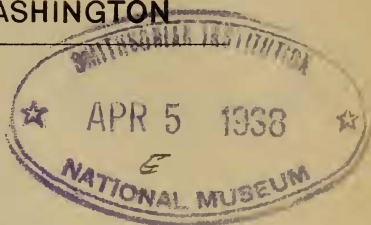

GENERAL NOTES.

A SUBSTITUTE NAME FOR FELIS CONCOLOR YOUNGI.

To Mrs. Arthur J. Poole I am indebted for bringing to my attention the name *Felis youngi* Pei (Palaeontologia Sinica, ser. C., vol. 8, fasc. 1, p. 133, May, 1934). This name, for a fossil species from the Lower Pleistocene of China, preoccupies *Felis concolor youngi* Goldman (Proc. Biol. Soc. Washington, vol. 49, p. 137, August 22, 1936) for the puma of southern Texas. The Texas animal was named by me for Stanley P. Young, and is here rechristened *Felis concolor stanleyana*.
