WESTRALIADISCUS GEN. NOV. A REPLACEMENT NAME FOR NINGBINGIA COOK. Memoirs of the Queensland Museum 43(2): 552. 1999: Ningbingia, with type species N. robertsi Cook 1998 was erected for a large tropidodiscine from the Westwood Member of the Hargreaves Formation, Late Devonian (Frasnian), Bonaparte Gulf Basin, Western Australia. The name is invalid as it is preoccupied by the modern pulmonate Ningbingia Solem 1981. I propose the new generic name Westraliadiscus gen. nov. in replacement of Ningbingia Cook, 1998. The name is for the state of Western Australia.
