

WESTRALIADISCUS GEN. NOV. A REPLACEMENT NAME FOR NINGBINGIA COOK. *Memoirs of the Queensland Museum* 43(2): 552. 1999 :- *Ningbingia*, with type species *N. robertsi* Cook 1998 was erected for a large tropidodiscine from the Westwood Member of the Hargreaves Formation, Late Devonian (Frasnian), Bonaparte Gulf Basin, Western Australia. The name is invalid as it is preoccupied by the modern pulmonate *Ningbingia* Solem 1981. I propose the new generic name *Westraliadiscus* gen. nov. in replacement of *Ningbingia* Cook, 1998. The name is for the state of Western Australia.
