SCHMIDTINA, A GENUS OF JAPANESE SCULPINS.

In a recent paper on the Cottide or Sculpins of Japan, by the present writers, a new genus, *Schmidtia*, was defined for a species of sculpin, *Schmidtia misakia*, from near Misaki, Japan. As the name *Schmidtia* is already used in zoology, we would substitute for it, as the name of the genus of *Cottide*, the name *Schmidtina*, the species being *Schmidtina misakia*.
