ON SUMATRAN LUCANIDAE

In a lot of Lucanoid beetles, captured in Deli (East-Sumatra) and sent to me for identification by Mr. J. D. Pasteur of Batavia (Java), I found the following species which were not yet recorded from Sumatra.

Hexarthrius mandibularis H. Deyr.

Prosopocoelus squamilateralis Parry.

Odontolabis Brookeanus Voll.

Eurytrachelus rama Boileau.

Aegus amictus H. Deyr.

» *Eschscholtzi* Hope.

» *bigibbosus* Rits.¹⁾

Nigidius obesus Parry.

Figulus rugosus H. Deyr.

With the exception of *Eurytrachelus rama* Boileau (le Naturaliste, 1897, p. 191, fig.) and of *Aegus bigibbosus* Rits. (ante p. 185) all these species are already known as belonging to the fauna of Borneo.
