

CESTRUM JARAMILLANUM: A CLARIFICATION

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ABSTRACT

Nomenclatural clarification is provided for *Cestrum jaramillanum*.

The name *Cestrum jaramillanum* Benítez & D'Arcy, commemorating the name of Jaime Lucio Jaramillo Asanza, Quito, Ecuador, was deliberately published without the letter *q* for euphonic reasons. This conforms with Article 23.2 of the *International Code of Botanical Nomenclature* (1994).

To date the name has been used this way in oral and visual presentations and in two publications now in press: *Revision of the Venezuelan Cestreae (Solanaceae): Cestrum and Sessea*, Annals of the Missouri Botanical Garden, and *Studies of Cestreae of Venezuela*.
