NOMENCLATURAL CHANGES IN DUDLEYA (CRASSULACEAE) AND CUPRESSUS (CUPRESSACEAE)

ABSTRACT

For the forthcoming revision of W.L. Jepson's Manual (Jepson, Man. Fl. Pl. Calif. [1925]), two species of Dudleya (Crassulaceae) are combined under D. abramsii Rose. In addition, Cupressus goveniana Gordon var. pigmaea Lemmon (Cupressaceae) is changed to subspecific rank.

Hoover (1965) noted in describing Dudleya bettinae Hoover that it was closely related to D. murina Eastw., which Moran had reduced to a subspecies of D. abramsii Rose in 1957. Though Hoover declined to discuss a "possible close relationship" of D. bettinae and D. murina to D. abramsii, all three entities share similar floral characteristics (e.g., simple bifurcate inflorescence, pale yellow flowers generally with fine purple to red lines on keel, short [mostly < 5 mm] pedicels). Similarly, Moran (1948) noted that D. parva shares essentially the same floral features with D. abramsii. As a result, the following two combinations are presented.

Dudleya abramsii Rose subsp. bettinae (Hoover) Bartel, comb. nov. BA-SIONYM: Dudleya bettinae Hoover, Leafl. West. Bot. 10:186. 1965.

Dudleya abramsii Rose subsp. parva (Rose & Davidson) Bartel, comb. nov. BASIONYM: Dudleya parva Rose & Davidson, Bull. So. Calif. Acad. 22:5. 1923.

In keeping with the use of subspecies in the treatment of *Cupressus* for the revision of W.L. Jepson's Manual and in Wolf's (1948) treatment of the genus, the following change in status is made.
