**A NECESSARY NEW NAME IN THE FAMILY HEBRIDAE
(HETEROPTERA: GERROMORPHA)**

Hebrus obscurus Cobben and Linnavuori [Cobben, R. H. and R. Linnavuori. 1983. Some new Hebridae from the Ivory Coast (Heteroptera, Gerromorpha). *Ann. Entomol. Fenn.* 49:83–86; *obscurus* on p. 85] is preoccupied by *Hebrus obscurus* Polhemus and Chapman [Polhemus, J. T. and H. C. Chapman. 1966. Notes on some Hebridae from the United States with the description of a new species (Hemiptera). *Proc. Entomol. Soc. Wash.* 68:209–212; *obscurus* (as *obscura*) on p. 210]. I here propose the replacement name *Hebrus linnavuorii* J. Polhemus for *Hebrus obscurus* Cobben and Linnavuori.—*John T. Polhemus, University of Colorado Museum, 3115 S.
