Suaeda Maritima, A Correction.—Suaeda maritima (L.) Dumort. was omitted from my list published in Rhodora xxviii. 37, 1926. I found this species on Charles River marsh, back of Stillman Infirmary, Cambridge, on September 22, 1923. The single specimen was fleshy and prostrate with up-carving branches, and Prof. M. L. Fernald pronounced it distorted. On October 23, 1894, I found a cluster of this species near the same spot. The plants were distorted, but not prostrate. Specimens of these plants are in my herbarium. This is the one species in my list affecting saline habitats.—Walter Deane, Cambridge, Massachusetts.
