International Theriological Congress

The First International Theriological Congress will be held in Moscow (USSR) on June 6—12, 1974.

The Congress will cover the main problems in the following fields of modern theriology:

1. Phylogeny, systematics, zoogeography, palaeotheriology
2. Morphology
3. Ecology
4. Ethology
5. Damage caused by mammals and its control
6. Utilization and conservation of mammals

The Programme will include plenary meetings, sectional meetings and specialized symposia. The symposia may work simultaneously with the sections. The preparation and holding of the symposia is effected by their convenors in coordination with the Organizing Committee. Suggestions on the themes of the symposia can be forwarded to the Organizing Committee.

The official languages of the Congress are English, Russian and French. At some of the meetings simultaneous translation will not be provided.

Abstracts of the papers are to be published at the beginning of the Congress.

The registration fees are as follows:

Congress members — 40 roubles
Accompanying persons — 20 roubles

The participants of the Congress will be catered for by the All-Union Joint-Stock Company for Foreign Tourism INTOURIST which will reserve accommodations in one of the central-hotels. Accommodation should be reserved through any of the tourist firms representing INTOURIST which will simultaneously see to your obtaining the visa.

After the Congress is over, the participants can take a tour of the USSR. For them INTOURIST will provide tours of picturesque parts of the country. A special programme is being developed for those accompanying the participants of the Congress which will include visiting museums sightseeing in Moscow and its neighbourhood.

Scientists who wish to participate in the Congress are to forward to the Organizing Committee the following information:

5. The topic of your paper if you wish to contribute it
