NEW AND RARE MOTHS IN EASTBOURNE. — Upon the evening of the 19th October, 1977 I took an example of *Helicoverpa armigera* Hbn. (Scarce Bordered-straw), possibly a migrant and a species that has never before been recorded from Eastbourne. Earlier, upon the 15th October, I took a single *Aporophyla nigra* Haw.
