NOTE ON FURTHER BRITISH LOCALITIES FOR *PISIDIUM STEENBUCHII*, MÖLLER, AND *P. LILLJEBORGII*, CLESSIN. (Read 10th June, 1910.)—Through the kindness of Mr. C. S. Carter, of Louth, Lincolnshire, I have received specimens of *Pisidium Steenbuchii*, Möll., from two localities in that county, namely, Tetney Lock, near Cleethorpes, and Grisel Bottom, Burwell Wood, near Louth. In the latter locality it is associated with *P. personatum*.

A yet more interesting record is that due to Mr. A. W. Stelfox, who has obtained *P. Steenbuchii* in association with *P. Lilljeborgii* from Keel Lough, Achill Island, co. Mayo, the other species of *Pisidium* present being *P. subtruncatum* and *P. Casertanum*.

In the Collection of the Conchological Society at Manchester are some specimens of *P. Steenbuchii* obtained by Dr. R. F. Scharff at Frankfort-on-the-Main. This is the most southerly locality for it that I am acquainted with.
