Note on further British Localities for Pisidium Steenbuchii, MÖLLER, AND P. LILLJEBORGII, CLESSIN. (Read 10th June, 1910.)—Through the kindness of Mr. C. S. Carter, of Louth, Lincolnshire, I have received specimens of Pisidium Steenbuchii, Möll., from two localities in that county, namely, Tetney Lock, near Cleethorpes, and Grisel Bottom, Burwell Wood, near Louth. In the latter locality it is associated with P. personatum.

A yet more interesting record is that due to Mr. A. W. Stelfox, who has obtained P. Steenbuchii in association with P. Lilljeborgii from Keel Lough, Achill Island, co. Mayo, the other species of Pisidium present being

In the Collection of the Conchological Society at Manchester are some specimens of *P. Steenbuchii* obtained by Dr. R. F. Scharff at Frankfort-on-the-Main. This is the most southerly locality for it that I am acquainted with.
