TRICHOGONIA ROSSMAESSLER, 1835 LAMELLIBRANCHIATA: PROPOSED SUPPRESSION UNDER THE PLENARY POWERS. Z.N.(S.) 1702

The object of this application is the suppression of the generic name *Trichogonia* Rossmaessler, 1835. This name was published in 1835, the reference being "Icones Land und Süsswasser Moll. Europ., v. 1, pe. 1, p. 112". The type, by monotypy, is *Mytilus polymorphus* Pallas. This species is also the type of *Dreissena* van Beneden published the same year. Since the generic name *Dreissena* has been placed on the Official List of Generic Names in Zoology under Opinion 782, it would seem appropriate that its objective synonym *Trichogonia* be suppressed under the plenary powers for the purposes of the Law of Priority, and placed on the Official Index of Rejected and Invalid Generic Names. Accordingly 1 hereby request that such action be taken.
