

*Stated Meeting, June 21, 1867.*

Present, five members.

Mr. F. FRALEY, in the Chair.

Letters were read from the Physical Society of Berlin, February 18, 1867, and the Imperial Academy at Vienna, February 20, 1867, announcing donations to the Library. Also from the Superintendent of the Geological Survey of India, and the Physical Society of Berlin, acknowledging the receipt of publications.

Donations were announced, viz.: From the Royal Prussian Academy, from the Royal Prussian Union for Gardening and Plant Culture, and from the Physical Society at Berlin; from the Royal Academy of Sciences at Vienna; from the Royal Academy at Madrid; from the Society of Antiquaries, from the Chemical, from the Meteorological, and from the Royal Astronomical Societies of London; from M. Baillière and from M. Delesse of Paris; from the New Hampshire Historical Society; from the Boston Academy of Arts and Sciences; from the Worcester Lunatic Asylum; from the Young Men's Association of Buffalo; from the Albany, from the Wilmington, and from the Franklin Institutes; from the Friends' Association of Philadelphia; and the Editors of News and Library.

Pending nominations Nos. 573 to 579 were read.

Mr. Fraley from the Committee on Sites for Edifices on Penn Squares, reported progress.
