Stål gibt für seinen *C. pectoralis* an (loc. cit. pg. 664), dass die Halbdecken kurz, bisweilen abgekürzt sind und kaum über das zweite Abdominalsegment hinausragen; bei *C. saccharicida* ragen die Halbdecken stets wenigstens bis zum Hinterrande des vierten (auf das verlängerte Segment folgenden) Hinterleibssegmentes, bei dem einen Geschlechte sogar über den Hinterrand des fünften Hinterleibssegmentes hinaus.
