Fulvus. Alae anticae parte dimidia basali parteque apicali squamulis flavo-virescentibus metallicis sparsis, pone medium vitta lata longitudinali subobliqua flavo-virescente, plaga magna subrotundata fusca nitente interrupta, ornatae.

Alae posticae parte tertia basali sicut in alis anticis, parte media late smaragdina, limbo externo late fusco, serie lunularum smaragdinarum decorato, cauda ocelloque enucleato anali fuscis.

Alae subtus a *Pap. Peranthono* non distinguendae, quare in specie nostra sectiones *Pap. Daedali* atque *Peranthoni* conjunguntur.

Cui speciei illustrissimae (δ singulum ante oculos habeo) nomen amicissimi domini B. Neumoegen (New York) contribuere gaudeo.

Parnassius Delphius Eversm. var. *Stenosemus* mihi. — Ladak.

Alae posticae limbo externo translucido angustissimo, maculis quatuor caeruleis analibus externisque, limbo illo valde appropinquatis ornatae; ocello inferiore ochraceo, interdum toto nigro, margini externo magis appropinquato; ocelli superioris loco macula minima nigra (3 δ . 1 ♀).
