My dear Sir:- I send the *Spiranthes* which I take to be *S. Romanzoffiana*. I have never seen an authentic specimen, but I feel sure that this is of the species from the time of flowering (passing away Aug. 10, whereas *cerina* is just beginning), from the almost adhesion of lower sepals to the petals, from the lip contracted above the middle, and from the globular naked Callusites. Please let me know whether I am right.

Can you spare me some time an authentic specimen of *Rosa* *humilis*, Marsh. <sup>with a fragment which</sup> I am dreadfully puzzled over that and *lucida*.
