Dear Mr Watson.

The "simple
tricks" are correctly named. But

consisting of *Putteri*, *vestita*, *glauca*,
reticulata, *trifida*. you were
intending to send me two for
my "specimens when there" I

something like *glauca* and
something like *reticulata* - but
"unlike anything we have
under these names" at least.
Three years or more ago we
made a special collection of
bryozoa in Labrador and on an
average of about every 200
specimens I have found one
but only tried to do something
with it - the specimens were
