On receiving your last letter I immediately
turned to my specimens of *Baldina multiflora*
which I already had in my herbarium and found
it to be the very *Buphthalmum angustifolium*
of the Banksian herbarium - Indeed when I examined
the plant there I thought I knew it but could
not find it - never thinking of looking in *Baldina*
of which it has not the character. I have been again
to the Banksian herbarium to make sure of the matter
and I have no doubt of the identity of the two plants.

I have not received the small parcel you
speak of in your last letter - but one which you
sent last autumn has just come to hand - The steward
of the British Queen found five parcels in one of the
berths the voyage before last having the names
of Brown Lindley London myself & another upon
them without address - in consequence of which
they were very nearly being lost & as altogether what
would have been very much to be regretted as I see you
have kindly sent some unique specimens from your
herbarium - I shall take care to return them safely.
