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My dear Gray

I have just got through the
written paper in which I have had
very little to alter from Weddell's work
though I have carefully examined flowers
and fruit throughout. I am puzzled
however about *Heperocnide*. Does it really
stand and if it does is that to remove it
from near *Dryophila* to place it next to
Urtica? Gray let me know what you
think.

I think that *Ditemon* must come
next to *Dryophila* - it has often 3 stamens
and always the rudimentary ovary which
the monandrous genera never have.

I think also that *Memorialis* is best as a
section of *Porroptia*.

I would also put *Zenouinia filamentosa*
into *Parrotaria* leaving *Zenouinia* as
Zandichow intended for the very dissimilar
Z. arborea.

I think otherwise that Weddell's genera
are all good - though the whole tribe is
very nearly allied.
