My dear Gray

I have sent off to you from
New York a packet to contain a box

 I envy Hooker his trip. If I had been

 steadily working day after day at the
 Flora Australiensis - the specimen took
 me seven months without intermission
 and now I have been more than
 four at the Gramineae - which will
 still take me two more months - I am
 now going however for a fortnight's
 holiday down to General Allen's in
 Somersetshire. In the mean time my
 seventh and last volume is printing.

I was very glad to see that you are
 disposed to adopt my views of the structure

of grapes - It appears to me to simplify
 them very much - I call it my view
 but I find that others had preceded me
 though I took it up quite independently.
