not want more satisfactory.

Mr. Bennett did not notice
Pursh's S. reticulata for
he has not marked it in
the Prodromus. It may
have got early named
and placed in another
genus, when accident
only will discover it.

I am very much
obliged for your remembrance
of this sub¹². I hope
before long to mistake
the duplicatis, and

to see what will be
of interest to you —
I am yet busy with
my public room, but
am getting it in shape.
