\*457. I found only one plant, the only one I ever saw. It was not more than two feet tall. The other plants of this genus bloom in the Spring. It seems to me that this must be new. I could find only three good specimens in blossom, ten of which - the best, I send to you.

You'll great difficulty in obtaining even the few seeds of Mirabilis multiflora I send to you. They will germinate and grow I feel sure, the flower is handsome. If I can be of service to you how do not hesitate to command me.
