

Ruffalo, June 12, 1865.

My dear George:

- I shall put into the Express for you, to-morrow, a small packet, containing -

 - 2nd - A perhaps singular form of *Carex* *bederi*.

- These things are not dried, & whatever you may wish to keep, will have to be attended to

I hope to be able, this week,
to visit Sunkie Creek & get a lot
of bellium seed for you.

I have taken to grubbing at the
masses &c. - I have got some pretty
fellows. Then too, I have found
Dioscorea species of *Reboulia* hem-
ispheric in fruit. How wonderful
by full earth is of admirable
things!
