

Wilmington Nov. 7 1881

Dear Mr. Eaton

The bundles came all right. I have only just now had time to look them over. The Sicilian plants are very nice and interesting. Many of the seeds are good and the whole collection is perfect. Of the latter I find two labels missing. The one of an *Aster* placed in the parcel between *Sarcocolla waltata* Nutt + *Erigeron Bloomeri*, I take it to be *A. Dimpasii* Lindl. The other is a *Phacelia* with the habit of *P. ciliolata* var *calycosa* + probably, I suppose, a form of that species. It is placed between *Aquilegia flavescens* + *Pachystima Meyersii*. Will you be so kind as to send me a card ~~with~~ saying whether or not my surmises are correct?
