

Wilmington Nov. 13 1855

My Dear Dr. Gray

I send by mail today additional specimens of Druce's plants as follows. No. 722 which from the white wool I still suppose to be *Splopappus Macrorama*; 702 the *Erigeron* near *E. ochroleucus*, Nutt. 452 the *Plantago*; Also some other numbers for which you will find labels enclosed. All the specimens you have of the above you may as well keep if you want them as I have duplicates; and this also applies to the following numbers of which Druce has sent me other specimens: viz 713, 715, 705, 740, 530 846 & 549. - or if names are preferred I call them *Senecio ~~integerrimus~~* *integerrimus* (Mr. Druce says it always has

single head) *S. crassulus*?, *Ergium*  
between *E. caespitosa* & *E. botanica*, *Alia*  
*retroscendens*, *Tellina pentacosta*, and  
the doubtful *oxytropis*. And as I  
said yesterday keep any others  
you may need or desire.
