examined the plants. Moreover
the argument as to locality, is
only good thus far; that it is
different from the interior plant,
in development. This does not
account for the differences in the
floral organs, &c. However I will

again examine when you send my
sheet back. I have also send the
ms.

It is proper to say that I
have not seen the "Cascade" ^{alt.}
plant mentioned in Bot. Cal., -
nor any specimens intermediate
between the Washington & the
interior plant. But there is no
variation of any account in any
specimens for Utah to ^{Arizona} Montana
& westward.
