

Amsinckia longiflora. This
plant differs from *A. vernicosa*, H. & A.
in the following characters;

Stem two feet high, setose ^{-hirsutely} throughout;
leaves linear to oblong-lanceolate,
setose ^{-hirsutely} on both sides. Calyx con-
sisting apparently of three sepals, -
two of which are generally notched
at the summit and sometimes
have a double midrib, sepals
4" - 6" long; limb of the corolla half
as long as the tube, the latter
contracted below the middle, 6" - 7"
in length; stamens inserted about
the middle of the corolla tube,
filaments very short; nutlets
more or less rusty-spotted, somewhat
concave on the dorsal face, not
subsate on the inner angle.
