my finds in time for Chapman's  
new Ed. I will send some of them  
to Engelmann - I think you overlooked  
my Nos 145 & 148. I hope Prof Sargent  
handed you the curious Orchid I  
sent him green - He ignores my  
two *Pisonias* & the *Caastophyllum*  
but they are certainly new to our  
Flora. Please examine my  
*Hymenopappus* of Fascicle IV & see  
if it is not *Parthenium Hystrophorum*  
I found the true *Hymenopappus* last spring -

Some of the names in your list I presume to be synonyms of Chapman's names, viz:

- Ocimum micranthum*  
= *O. Campochianum* of Chapman.  
*Amarantus crassifolius*  
= *Sclerophyllum* " "  
*Coelestina maritima* "  
= *Agratum littorale*  
*Metastilma Blodgettii*  
= *M. parviflorum* "

I have just sent a lot of copy to Mr. Patterson, but cannot give the authorities for the names.

*Sporia micrantha* DeCarse  
*Vaccinium Cubense*, Griseb.

Will you be so kind as to write them on the enclosed card & mail to him -

follow *Simarubaceae*, 441\*

Following Dr. Chapman's arrangement I have numbered *Picramnia* as following *Vitaceae* - 461\*

If this is much out of the way I wish you would tell Mr. P. which genus it should follow.

*Fugozia* I have numbered <sup>598\*</sup> ~~386\*~~  
*Malachra* " " ~~383\*~~ ~~361\*~~

These are Mann's Nos

If you think it worth while to change those Nos please suggest the right ones to Mr. Patterson - Perhaps you have more correct names for the *Picramnia* & *Fugozia* of Chapman's *Addendum*.
