

Albany Sept 17th 1838

Dear Sir

Enclosed I send you Coulthay's order for Thirty Dollars which you can transmit to me in notes of your City Banks by some early opportunity. At the time I paid C. the amount of my contribution I also gave him an addition al Ten Dollars to purchase for me at Boston, some cheap linen pantaloons, similar to some of his own, this he neg lected to do, no doubt in consequence of the uncertainty of the individuals ~~not~~ to be selected to accompany the Ex: vice then, however, it appears to have escaped his memory. I do not know that you consider yourself authorized to return it from the funds you hold of him but I sincerely wish you would, for I shall be most sadly in need of it e'er long. I feel perfectly convinced that he would have not the slightest objection to your doing as he would himself have done had he ~~been~~ been reminded of it. Let me know when you start for your new station, otherwise, what success your new work meets with for I feel some interest as to its welfare.
