You know, that I was going to Mexico for making
botanical collections, I have been here for one year
and more and have made many collections. For
sending you all these plants I wrote already
a long time since, but received no answer.
I do not know, if you received my letter or
not. My journey from Vera Cruz to the city
of Mexico was recorded in my letter. I made
now another journey to the Sierra de Caliente
and live at present about 30 leagues N. W. from
Tuxtepec in a ~~very~~ beautiful country, full of new
plants of all classes. I made also here already
great collections and would like to send them
to your disposition; whenever I expect your
answer. They are to be sent by way of Tuxtepec
I will stay here for some years, and it appears
that my botanical harvest will be very great.
