Dear Sir,

Along with my hurriedly written epistle

to time. For Prof. Peirce's Anal. Mech. \$7 will be wanted as soon as the work
is ready; can you tell me where that will be? I owe Z. A. Gould \$5 for Ast.

diggings". If there is any one entitled to give receipt for him do pay the bill.
The rest of the draft will vanish in some other way and leave nothing but not disconsolate
