

To Dr. Gray -

Extract from a letter of Ch. Godet
Nov. 1st 1864 - (Translation)

"The grasses of the collection (Hull & Harbor) are by the way, very badly determined, species mixed, sometimes three times under the same number - Here are some of the errors -

No 682 is a Coleobuchus (Alopec. glaucus Lessing) and not at all Alopec. pratensis or alpestris! which is very different.

No 684 is the true Phleum alpinum L.

No 673 Agrostis rubra L. (not Agrostis trapestris.)

No 649 - Calamagrostis stricta! - but mixed with another new species which resembles a condensed form of Calamagrostis canadensis, but has culms & spikelets scabrous & which I have named C. oreophila.

No 624. has no relation to agreement with C. Sylvatica, but rather with C. Cookiana Torr.

No 668. is not a Poa but probably a Dufourea (in Arenaceae) a genus which I do not yet know.

No 672 - very distinct species from Poa serotina Europe (P. Hallii Viki), however the true serotina is also found in the collection.

No 629 Glyceria aquatica Americanus.

It is very different from ours.

No 678 This is not a Poa but a Glyceria
near G. festucaformis.

No 650. Is not Koehleria cristata, but
rather K. glauca DC.
