of Collections of 1861 & 1862. If you can

arrange to get them for him
by exchanging I can furnish
the material to exchange for them
but this is the most I can do as I
understand it let me know how
this can be done & I will go about
it with a will.

payable to me. I can use it now
on receipt. Dr Engelman has
written me also sent me *Synopsis*
Cuscuta, *Cactacea* & *Dissectiones*
wants information about the condensed

the Carices? I wrote him to do so
I can send you Hooker's plants at any
time & sets when needed.
