on all the species sent him - I wrote
you last week enclosing samples
of no 195 - = *Crataegus* *Coarctata* form;
and 292 - a *galiceous* they you have
probably got now 464 is also
missing in my set & no doubt through
out the whole - mistakes will some-
times happen 471 I enclose you
a bit of a *Placchi* or rather *nanophyl*
593 *Carya* *porcina* & 594. *C. amara*
a form with ampliate leaves nothing like
it here 594 is *Quercus Durandii*
So Buckley said & he described
it I know the oaks are all in complete
but the forms & hybrids turned up so
interesting to me that I could not but
make a showing of them. Texas is the
best place I have visited for hybrid
forms & varieties in this family. Buckley
has another species he calls *Q. Texana*
but I could not find it. no doubt

a hybrid or form of *D. palustris*
reduced by arid station & soil
I wrote Col Olney last
to send one he may be sick
he was when I last heard from him
