Dear Mr. Gray

I returned the list
yesterday, having forgotten
until you reminded me,
that you wished to see
it again. I have copied
all of it, and I am
having your new genus
of Guleans figured. I also
intend having one or two
of the new species of *Arctopis*
drawn. Parry & Palmer's 590
I have described as
Lachnostoma (Chthasidia) bifidum

In floral structure it is
very near *Celtis biflora*,
I am describing a few
Compositae as I go along,
but as you are coming to
England in the Autumn
I need not trouble you
concerning them by letter.
With regard to *Greenella*, I
may be wrong, but I think
it is a very good *Gutierrezia*,
and very near *Spur. g. spha.*
rocephala and *microcephala*.
By the bye my northern
boundary is the Gila river
so *Greenella* is within it.

This boundary is convenient
because easily defined, but
I adopted it mainly because
many of the old "Sonora"
plants might be from southern
Arizona or North Mexico, and
it is not easy to decide which.
The "*Lithospermum*" does not
appear to be represented in
Herb. New.

The last part of the
Polypetala will be published
next month, and there will
be an interval of six months
before we commence with
the *Gonopetala*.
