MEMORANDUM.

To Prof Lewis Watson
Cambridge Mass.

Dec 29th 1888.

My Dear Sir,

I cant say that I ever saw any fruit of vitis riparia that I called good, yet I have sometimes seen fruit that was much larger and sweeter than the average from this species. I buy usually from 15 to 30 barrels of the riparia, each year, for the seed, and have probably seen fruit of most of the bearing vines within a radius of 8 or 10 miles.

Mr. Pringle arrived here on the 24th and you will no doubt hear from him as soon as he gets settled to his work. He seems to have had a successfull season and has about 40 sets of 300 species.
