Oregon July 20, 1878.

My dear Mr. Watson

I send you a package of plants by mail to day I wish you would name them for me. I do not think that there is any thing new among them but I hope that some of them may be of interest to you. several of them were collected near the base of Mt. Hood by my brother T. J. Howell, recently. The others were collected by him and myself in the Klickitat valley, Eastern Washington Territory.

- ↓ No. 64 Is a pensedamnum collected by T. J. Howell Near Mt Hood Oregon June, 1878
- ↓ No 65 Grows very abundant in stony places Klickitat valley May, 1878. This appears to be pensedamnum massorcarpum but I don't think it is the same as No 9.
- No. 66. pensedamnum Klickitat W. Va May 1878

The specimen marked at My Brother says
is the flowers he collected it Feb. 15 1848

- No 67 Resembles the last but the bulbs are
fully four times as large Kliskatot May, 1848.

- No 68, *Thlaspium* ^{*magnum*, var. *occidentalis*} Near Mt. Hood June, 1848

- No 69 *Ranunculus* ^{*glaberrimus*, H.} Kliskatot valley Feb & April 1848

- No 70 " *Hedera*, Rep. ^{good fine} Feb, 15, 1848.

- No 71 *Caltha*. Perhaps *C. leptosepala* Near Mt Hood in 1848

- No 72 *Nicola* ^{*palustris*} Near Mt. Hood grows in marshes

- No 73 " ^{*Bicknelli*, var.} Kliskatot April, 1848.

- No 74 ^{*cordata*, *cordifolia*, *longa*} Near Mt. Hood. grows in creeks.

- No 75 Appears to be a *Stansia* as sometimes
^{*Miltiophyllum tenuifolium*, H.} near it Dalles of Columbia river Aug July 1848

- No 76 Kliskatot-vally W. T. May, 1848.

- No 77 I think is a *Thysanocarpus* ^{*hirsutus*, H.} Kliskatot Marsh

- No 78 With the last May 1848. *T. glaucus* ^{*var. cuneipennis*}

- No 79 Grows in ^{*Platypodium* *scapigerum*, H.} wet places Kliskatot - March 1848

- No 80 Near Mt. Hood June 1848. Mr. Knott says it is *Fragaria* ^{*Rubus pudens*, H.}

- No 81 *Spiraea*, ^{*Whitneyana*} grows with the last

- No 82 Is undoubtably *pussia tridentata* I

- No 83 Near the Dalls Oregon June 1848

- J No. 84, Is a *Ghosackia*. Creek bottom
^{*minitoria*, H.} eastern slope of Cascade Mts July 1, 1848.
- J No 85 *Trifolium* ^{*longipes*, H.} In marshes Near Mt Hood June, 1848.
- J No 86 Kliskatot valley May, 1848.
- J No 87 With the last. *Astragalus Purshii*
- J No. 88 With the last. *Astragalus revolutus*, Gray, n.sp.
- J No. 89 Peches near ^{*lacustre*, var. *parvulum*} Mt. Hood June, 1848.
- J No. 90 " ^{*viscidissimum*} east slope of Cascade Mts. June, 1848.
- J No. 91 *Ceanothus*, Hood river Aug. July, 1848.
- J No. 92 perhaps *Ceanothus prostratus* Kliskatot, May, 1848
- J No 93 perhaps *Spraguea umbellata* Mt Hood
- at the snow line June 1848.
- J No 94 *Saxifrage* ^{*integritaria*} Kliskatot - May, 1848.
- J No. 95 Grows in ^{*Saxifrage integritaria*, var.} marshes, over Mt. Hood June, 1848.
- J No 96, Grows along creeks, near Mt. Hood June, 1848.
- J No 97 With the last, perhaps *Melkella trifida*.
- J No. 98 ^{*roundifolia*, var. *broadistata*} *Pyrola*. Near Mt Hood, June, 1848.
- J No. 99 With the last. *Pyrola secunda*
- J No. 100 With the last. *Chimaphila umbellata*
- J No. 101 Eastern ^{*Pyrola minor*, L.} slope of Cascade Mts. June, 1848.
- J No. 102 *Vaccinium* ^{*myrtillidium*, H.} base of Mt Hood, June, 1848.
- J No. 103. Near Mt. Hood, June, 1848.
- J No. 104 Seems to be an *Oreasterophytes*, Mt Hood, June, 1848.
- J No. 105 Is a *Gentian* ^{*Europa*, var. *arctica*} Near Mt. Hood, June, 1848.
- J No. 106 Is a *Pedicularis*, Marshes near Mt. Hood.

Henry *Chelone* *Chelone*
No. 107, No. 108 & No. 109 are Pentstemons from near
the base of Mt. Hood at a place called Laurel
hill June, 1848.

No. 110 *Mimulus* ^{Lewisii, Ph.} with red flowers it grows in creeks
in the Cascade Mountain. June 1848.
No. 111 is a very small *Mimulus* ^{Klickitat} _{robustus, var.} May 1848.

No. 112 ~~Sims~~ Sims mountains, W. T. May, 1848.

No. 113 *Gilia* ^{Aphyllon uniflorum} _{spp.} Near the Dalles Oregon, June, 1848. *G. liniiflora*
_{spp.} ^{speciosus} _{speciosus} var. *phenaxoides*.

No. 114 No. 115. & No. 116 On plot. Klickitat Valley, May, 1848.

No. 117 ^{Colonia} _{var. rugosa} another *Gilia* bottom lands Klickitat July 1848.

No. 118 Klickitat valley W. T. May, 1848. *Metunia* ^{Monspur}

No. 119 Marshes ^{Metunia paniculosa} near Mt. Hood June, 1848. Most of my
water plants from the Cascade mountains got
badly damaged. I am sorry the specimens are so poor.

No. 120 grows next the last. *Valeriana capitata*, var.

- No. 121 *Aconitum*. The flowers were not found. It has little bulbs
in place of them. Along creeks near Mt. Hood. June, 1848.

- No. 122 *Polygonum* ^{Davicia} at the snow line on Mt. Hood June 26, 1848

- No. 123 *Carallaria* Cascade Mts June 1848

- No. 124 *Corallaria* plant pure white except the inside of the
lip which is yellow. Very rare. Near Portland Oregon, June, 1848.

- No. 125, perhaps *Liatris cordata* No. 126 with the last near Mt. Hood

- No. 127 Klickitat. Flowers February. Fruit - May, 1848.

^{Xerophyllum tenax, Nutt.}

- No. 128. *Oxalis* Cascade Mts No. 129. Cascade Mts June 1848.

^{Tofieldia} ~~guttae~~ *occidentalis*, W.

- No. 130 *Calochortus* Cascade Mts. June, 1848 A neat little plant.

- No. 131 This is an odd plant grows in marshes near Mt. Hood.
